






Winter Weather

Remembrance Day

gratitude and honour we feel for the sacrifices made by our war veterans, past and present. We will be singing "Light a Candle for Peace" and parents and guardians are invited to attend the assembly. *Please note: seating and access to the gym will be extremely limited.

Following the assembly, the students will have the opportunity to eat their lunch and join some of the GEC students at the school. *Please ensure your child is dressed in their choir uniform of dark bottoms, dark shoes.* The students will be provided with a white choir shirt that was kindly provided by the PAC.
