## **Creative Arts & Crafts with Tracey (after school program)**



## **Bird Friendly Workshop**

On **Friday, January 17**<sup>th</sup> students will participate in a bird-friendly workshop with some members from the Lions Bay Bird Friendly Society.

Did you know that Lions Bay is the first Small Town in Canada to be certified a Bird Friendly City? The village was awarded this designation in May of 2022 for their work in reducing threats to birds, protecting and restoring natural habitats and increasing climate resiliency. We are looking forward to learning more about the local bird community on this day!

### **Lockdown Drill**

Lions Bay students and staff will conduct our annual lockdown drill on **Tuesday**, **January 28**<sup>th</sup> in collaboration with the Squamish RCMP and West Vancouver School District staff. A school lockdown is initiated when a potential threat is detected either within the school or outside of the school building.
