
WEST VANCOUVER SCHOOLS

We are looking forward to this event and thank you for your support!


GEC PAC Fundraiser

Traffic Advisory

Beginning, **Monday April 28**th, watermain construction on Eagleridge Drive, between HWY 1 Exit 2A/Eagleridge Drive and Marine Drive will be taking place. Construction is <u>expected to take 3 months</u>, depending on underground conditions encountered. Construction impacts can be expected as follows:

- Full road closure during work hours on Eagleridge Drive, between HWY 1 Exit 2A/Eagleridge Drive and Marine Drive. Local access will remain, however, there may be temporary delays or parking restrictions.
- Construction signage and traffic control personnel will be on-site to facilitate traffic flow and pedestrian safety.
- Work will take place Monday to Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m., or as necessary to complete the project.
- Emergency vehicle access will always remain during construction.

Please be aware that access to Marine Drive and HWY 1 via Eagleridge Drive will be limited during work hours; detours should take place via Horseshoe Bay Drive.

Project updates will be provided at westvancouver.ca/traffic when available.
