First Day of School

Our staff at both Gleneagles Ch'axáý and Lions Bay are looking forward to the first day of school on **Tuesday**, **September 2nd.** Students in **Grades 1-7** are expected to be in attendance according to the times listed below:

Lions Bay School	Students will be in attendance from 8:45 to 9:45 am. All students are asked to enter through the door labelled with a deer
Gleneagles Ch'a <u>x</u> áý	Students in attendance from 8:35 am to 9:35 am; parents are invited to the gym for our PAC-hosted Welcome Back Tea & Coffee.
	Returning students should report to their last year's classroom for attendance at the welcome bell. All students NEW TO GEC are asked to meet in the basketball court at the back of the school. Students do not need to bring anything with them on the first day.

We look forward to welcoming our new Kindergarten students on Wednesday, September 3rd (as per the gradual entry instructions emailed in July).

As a reminder, in order to secure a place for the 2025-26 school year, students are expected to be in attendance by Thursday, September 4th. If your child <u>will not</u> be in attendance before this time, please email <u>mapistilli@wvschools.ca</u> or leave a message on the Call Back line at 604-981-1360 with your child's name, grade, reason for absence, and expected date of return. Lions Bay Bus

Please note that Lions Bay bus service will begin on Tuesday, September 2nd with only drop off service available on this day (no return trip to Lions Bay will be available). Please arrange to have your child picked up from school on Tuesday if you are using the bus service. Full AM/PM service will begin on Wednesday, September 3rd. All students living in the Lions Bay corridor who wish to use the LB bus service must register annually through our district site here.

<u>Important</u>: if your child is not registered, they will not be able to use the bus service as this causes a liability issue for our school district. Please ensure that registration has been completed as soon as possible.
