Treasurer's Report - Kate Saunders

Balance Sheet

As of October 1st, we have \$92,930 in our bank accounts, which includes our Operating,

Gaming, and Trust Account and Petty cash: \$500. Our total liabilities are just over \$40, 000. This is comprised of:

\$2,000 for hot lunch vendor accrual

\$14,000 for gym audio/tech upgrade accrual

\$1,284 Munchalunch credits

We currently have retained earnings of \$57,000.

Income Statement

We had another successful year with our revenue-generating events totaling \$41K.

Highlights for the year include:

\$2K in Hot Lunch sales profit

\$7.4K from the Spring Golf Tournament

\$6.2K from the Pump Up the Jam fundraiser

\$2.0K from the Fall Fair

\$5.3K with the Gaming Grant (based on \$20/student)

\$1.5K from the Movie Day fundraiser, and \$1K for other Online fundraising, such as

Babysitting/First Aid course, and \$700 from Spirit Wear

\$700 in Interest Income from our Trust Account

Notable expenditures so far this year include:

- \$500 on playground equipment
- Funds released for principal discretion and classroom funds.
- \$1,800 on teacher's wish list items (with \$715 remaining).
- The Welcome Back barbecue was \$325 over budget.

Hot lunch is underway and off to a great start. We offered up some healthy options for the students and gave parents a break from making lunches every day while raising funds for the school. Thank you to all the families who ordered, our amazing vendors, Munchalunch and school staff for lunch delivery and e-bulletin updates.

Some notes on the vendors:

There are currently 186 hot lunch orders, generating over \$7,300 in profit.

- Terry Fox's niece, Aaron Fox, gave an assembly.
- Outdoor school had four parent volunteers for grades four and five (72 students).
- Welcome back barbecue: Huge thank you to everyone that helped out there.
- Munchalunch: Thank you to Sonia and Russell.
- Frisbees and balls were purchased for each division (10 classes). New shelving was added in two classrooms for cubbies. New tables were purchased for Mrs. Harquail's class. A new carpet was installed in another classroom.
- World Teachers Day is coming up.
- FSAs (foundational skills assignment assessments) will begin next week for grades

four and seven. A letter has been sent to families in those grades.
