Term 1 Learning Updates

Parents at both Gleneagles and Lions Bay schools will receive their child's Learning Updates (student reports) for Term 1 tomorrow afternoon, **December 5**^{th.} Please ensure that you have access to your child(ren)'s reports by logging into the MyEd BC Family Portal account. If you cannot access your account, please try the password reset feature, if that fails, you are asked to review the information on the District help page here: West Vancouver Schools Family Portal

The Family Portal is where all parents will go to access their child's Learning Update as well as Individual Student Plans (IEP's), ELL grades (AIP's) and other student data which is part of our school database, MyEd BC. This is an important component of how our school delivers student information to parents and families and will be used all the way through high school. It is important that parents set up this account and save a pdf copy of your child's reports as hard copies will not be sent home and will not be provided from the school office.

If you are a <u>new</u> family to our school District, you have received an email from the MyEd BC server inviting you to initialize your Family Portal account - you may need to check your junk folder if you do not see an email in your inbox. Please follow the instructions in that email carefully to initialize the account by replacing the temporary password. This must be done on a COMPUTER and will not work on a phone or tablet.

Hot Lunch for Term 2

Exciting news! Hot Lunch is now open for orders for Term 2 and we're **removing the open and close windows** so you can place orders at any time! You will still be able to order for the full term ahead, however you will now be able to go back in and make changes up to two weeks before each delivery date.

Please note that orders will automatically close at 8pm, 14 days before each lunch delivery, giving families greater flexibility to adjust their orders. When making changes, **please double check the new start date** for your child's lunch and remember that any changes will take effect after two weeks.

For example: parents go into Munch-A-Lunch and place an order for the entire term, your child comes home and says "I don't want mac and cheese anymore". You can now go back to Munch-A-Lunch, go to the mac & cheese days, change the order, and then tell your child "you will have to eat your mac & cheese for 2 more weeks until it changes to the new order".

Hot lunch is served Tuesday to Friday and we are continuing with the same vendors as Term 1. If you have any inquiries after your child has received their meal, please contact the Hot Lunch coordinators at gechotlunch@gmail.com. (Please do not contact the food vendors directly).


Holiday Spirit
