Treasurer Update/ Intermediate Foyer (Emma):

Balance of accounts

HPAC account = \$36,459.76

Gaming Grant = \$19,455.19

Agreed costs to be covered by Gaming Grant funds are First Aid Training for grade 6 and 7 (this is approved in the budget) and to top up the supplies of sports jerseys for the sports teams. We may also produce a few extra to sell on munch a lunch.

The Intermediate Foyer project is ticking along nicely thanks to Earlene. Emily and the teachers have pulled together their wish list of items/furniture and now Earlene is meeting with suppliers to see how they can make this work in the space. Earlene is finding progress slow with suppliers but will continue following up.

Halloween Recap:

Thanks to the support of parents with our fundraising efforts we were able to purchase 201 pumpkins for our students to paint and carve out for Halloween this year! Kids were excited to take home a pumpkin. I had one teacher stop me as I was picking up our hot lunch bags and wanted to share how one of her students was so excited that he named his pumpkin and spoke to him!!! It's great that the kids were happy to have their own pumpkin. Only 2 divisions were not able to participate due to FSA's (Div 1 & 2).

I would like to do something similar for Christmas - maybe order a large candy cane per student and hand it out on the last day of school. Your thoughts? If everyone agrees, I will source them. The pumpkins were \$2 each as I went to a farm in Richmond and picked them up - otherwise here locally they were \$5 each. I can source a large candy cane individually wrapped/boxed for about \$2.50 each. We raise so much money each year with our fundraisers so I think it's important that we use it for the students while they are here. A little something goes a long way!

Hot Lunch Update

Term 2 ordering will run from Dec 6 - 17th with the first hot lunch delivered on Wednesday, January 5th. Term 2 hot lunch runs until Friday, March 11th.

Our distribution team has been doing such a great job with running the parent volunteers side of Hot Lunch. Bona, Bella and Mitsuko are doing an awesome job!!! Thank you ladies!!

I sent out a thank you email to all parents that made a straight donation while ordering lunch for Term 1. We raised \$785 as straight donations to PAC!!

As mentioned, Annie is no longer going to be taking over the role of running Hot Lunch so again if you know of anyone - this is a crucial role to fill.

DPAC Update (Asem):

I am going to turn it over to Asem to fill us in on the last general meeting held on November 3rd that Asem and I attended. Fundraisers for Term 1:
