This is important as we will be finalizing our school's organization based on enrollment numbers. Throughout the year, please continue to notify the office via voicemail or email when your child will be late or absent. Thank you!
Wednesday, September 6th	 Full school day with opening bell at 8:50am and dismissal at 2:50pm Students will be with their class from the previous year. They will only need to bring a pencil case with a pencil and pencil crayons. Students will participate in welcome back activities and learn about school routines, expectations, and guidelines. Students new to Hollyburn will meet in the Library and then be placed in classrooms with students in a similar grade. Kindergarten Gradual Entry begins. Separate communications for Gradual Entry were sent in early July.
Thursday, September 7th	Same details as Wednesday, however, students new to Hollyburn will go to the same classroom they were in on Wednesday. They do not need to report to the library.
Friday, September 8th	 All students including new students will return to the same classroom they were in on Thursday. During the school day, students will be assigned to their 2023-2024 classrooms.
