SCHOOL-AGED CHILD CARE DEMAND PARENT SURVEY	On behalf of the Ministry of Education and Child Care, we are sharing the survey information below to help inform the Province's ChildCareBC initiatives:  We know that many families depend on school-age child care to ensure their children have a quality, affordable, and inclusive place to be during a parent's full work day. That is why the Province's ChildCareBC plan is working to expand access to child care for all families that want and need it.  The Ministry of Education and Child Care is conducting a parent survey to better understand the regional and provincial demand for school age child care.  While we know there is unmet demand for school-aged child care, there is no current provincial or regional data quantifying the demand. Your participation will help the Province plan for future school-aged child care expansions.  This survey is intended for all parents, regardless of the type of child care you currently use or even if you are not using any child care at all.
