UPCOMING ROAD CLOSURE ON 15TH STREET

JAN 15TH TO MARCH 11TH

We want to make you aware of upcoming road work for BC Hydro, starting on Monday January 15th that requires the closure of 15th Street between Mathers Avenue and Queens Avenue, for approximately eight weeks. Pedestrian access will remain with Traffic Control Persons (flaggers) assisting where necessary. Details are below:

- Expect a full road closure on 15th Street, between Mathers Avenue and Queens Avenue, starting on Monday, January 15 for approximately eight weeks.
- The full closure on 15th Street will be in effect Monday to Friday, from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. After work hours and on weekends/holidays, single-lane alternating traffic will be in effect.
- Traffic control personnel and construction signage will be on-site to facilitate traffic flow.
- This work is related to the BC Hydro Glenmore Voltage Conversion project. Please see the long-term work below for more information.
