## Principal's report, Ms. Lloyd:

Looking back at October:

- Halloween dance & read a thon was a success and lots of fun. Fundraising goal is replace the school's supply of personal devices (IPads & Chromebooks).
- FSA's are winding up
- Haida Stories (Art Start) has visited the school
- Baseball Throwing Clinic was a success
- West Vancouver District Safety meeting Ms. Lloyd discussed with the West Van district traffic safely around the school. Concerns include cars speeding, double parking and cars missing the stop signs. This is a school where many students walk to school. Ms. Lloyd has requested that school zone signage around the school be improved and a sidewalk is put in along the south side of Esquimalt Street

Looking ahead:

- Remembrance day ceremony will be held on Nov 8<sup>th</sup>, 2024. This will be a student led assembly with guests from the district, local legion and West Vancouver Library
- Family Services of North Shore and Christmas Bureau. Resources are provided to families in need of support. The school might do a collection, possibly socks or hygiene products to donate.

- Playground Accessibility upgrades Playground will be renovated to improve accessibility. This will be funded by a grant. The construction should take approx. 2 weeks and will hopefully occur around or near spring break 2025.
