

Due to fire regulations and gym capacity limits, **WONDERLAND** each family may purchase 2 tickets for one performance only—either CONCERT the matinee or the evening. If additional tickets are available after the initial sales close, they may be available for purchase at the school **IMPORTANT** office starting Monday, December 9th, subject to availability. INFORMATION **PLEASE** Tickets for the show will be distributed to students by their classroom READ teachers on Tuesday, December 10th. Please note that a ticket is required for entry, and we will not be able to admit anyone who arrives without a physical ticket. Tickets are expected to sell out quickly, so we encourage families to purchase theirs early to secure a spot at their preferred performance. While we
