HAIDA STORIES AT HOLLYBURN



Kung Jaadee (Roberta Kennedy) is a professional storyteller, educator and published author. She belongs to the Xaayda (Haida), xwm Økw ym (Musqueam), Swxwú7mesh (Squamish), Tlingit, Tsleil-Waututh Nations, and is also part Hawaiian. For 30 years, she has performed traditional legends teaching

universal messages while also sharing personal stories about the history and hardships of her people. She has performed at hundreds of schools and festivals across Canada and is the published author of the children's books, "Raven's Feast," "Gifts from Raven," and two textbooks, "Haida Nation: Indigenous Communities in Canada" and "We Are Home."

WINTER WEATHER CLOTHING REMINDER



As we head into winter, please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for both wet and cold weather. Essential items include waterproof shoes or boots, a rain jacket, and spare socks, as well as warm layers like sweaters, toques, and mittens. It's also helpful to pack a spare set of clothes, including a t-shirt and pants.

In the event of an emergency, such as an earthquake or power outage, students may need to remain in an unheated building or outdoors for an extended period of time, so warm clothing is crucial. Additionally, we rarely have "inside recess" during rainy days, so students should be prepared to play outside in all weather conditions.

Please ensure that ALL items you send to school with your child are clearly labeled with their first and last name.

TYPING PAL SCHOOL EDITION



What is it? Typing Pal School Edition is a web-based application that encourages keyboarding practice for students, from beginner to intermediate. We are making this available to all students from Kindergarten to Grade 9.

Students should go to the unique url for their school: Typing Pal and choose "Log in with Google." If students have more than one Google account, they will be asked to choose their account - they should choose the school one.

When students first log in they are prompted to take a diagnostic type of test that will give the program an idea of where to start them. From there, the program will cater to each students' speed/ability.





HALLOWEEN COSTUME GUIDELINES AT HOLLYBURN



As families begin to source, make and purchase wonderful Hallowwen costumes for their children, we kindly ask students and families to follow

these guidelines for Halloween:

- Costume Choice: Students can wear a costume, Halloween colors, or simply come as they are — it's all welcome!
- Cultural Sensitivity: Please avoid costumes that promote cultural stereotypes. For information on cultural appropriation versus cultural appreciation, visit this website for more guidance if needed: UBC's Equity & Inclusion Office.
- Masks: Refrain from wearing full-face masks, except for health-related masks. We need to ensure student visibility and recognition.
- No Weapons: Do not bring items that resemble weapons.
- Comfort: Choose a comfortable costume that can be worn all day and is suitable for outdoor weather.
- Appropriate for All Ages: Remember, students from ages 4 to 13 will be participating, so keep costumes appropriate for a school setting.
- No Scented Products: Avoid scented items, such as certain hair sprays, that could affect others.
- Arrive Dressed: Students should come to school in their costumes. We won't have space or time for costume changes during the day.
- No Candy: We discourage students from bringing Halloween candy to school as it can distract from learning. Any candy brought may be returned at the end of the day.


