- Student Attendance: All students are expected to attend both evening performances. Their presence is essential to the success of the production.
- Arrival Times:
 - Cast Members: Please arrive by 4:30 PM and go directly to the music room.
 - Please arrive on time no late arrivals.
 - All Other Students: Please arrive by 5:10 PM and be dropped off at the exterior door of their classroom. (If your child is meeting outside a different classroom, their teacher will email you directly.)
- Performance Time:
 - The evening shows will run from 5:30 PM 6:45 PM.
- Student Pick-Up:
 - Students are to be picked up outside the same classroom door where they were dropped off.
- Arrival Requirements:
 - All students must arrive on time and in full costume, ready to go on stage.
 - Students are not to bring devices or electronic games.
- Audience Information:
 - Seating is first come, first serve.
 - No ticket sales at the door.
 - YOU MUST HAVE YOUR PHYSICAL TICKET WITH YOU TO ENTER
 - We kindly ask that no photos or videos be taken during the performance out of respect for student privacy and copyright laws.

Transportation and Parking

- School buses will pick up students from their school sites between 8:15–8:25
 AM.
- Students arriving with a parent driver must be at Terry Fox Field by 9:15 AM.
- Families, coaches, and spectators can park at the West Mall Complex Visitor Parkade. Use the code School for free parking.

Using the Paystation:

- At the pay station, enter in license plate
- Select "Event Rate" option
- Enter Coupon Code/Promo Code

Volunteers Needed!

- bleachers without back support, so a blanket or cushion is recommended for comfort. Students are expected to demonstrate respectful and responsible behaviour, in line with school and district codes of conduct.






