It has been a privilege and my pleasure to be of service to Hollyburn Elementary School as HPAC Chair and Hot Lunch Coordinator.

This was my 3rd year as hot lunch coordinator and we were able to increase hot lunch revenue by 59% an and sales by 41%. We added a 4th day of lunch service (Tuesdays) and in term 3 we added Aburi Sushi to the menu on Wednesdays.

Per our bylaws, the purpose of the HPAC is communication, from school administration with parents, at every meeting we start with a Principal's report. As well, to provide volunteer opportunities for parents including fundraising events where all funds raised are re-invested in the school.

I feel that when we have clear and cohesive goals, including fundraising goals, there is a lot of room for parental involvement with fundraising and events.

All parents & guardians of Hollyburn Students are by definition members of the HPAC and are welcome to attend meetings whenever they want and are able.

Thank you to all the parents who volunteered, participated in the fundraisers, donated on munchalunch and bought hot lunch. With your support we were able to achieve our fundraising goal for the year and buy a new supply of personal electronic devices, Chromebooks and iPads for the school.
