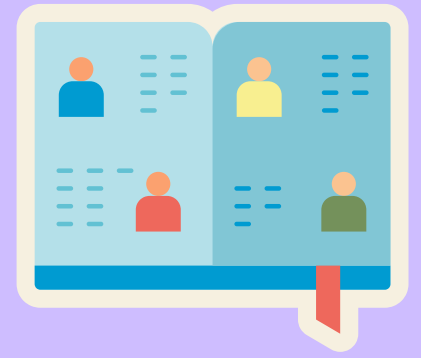

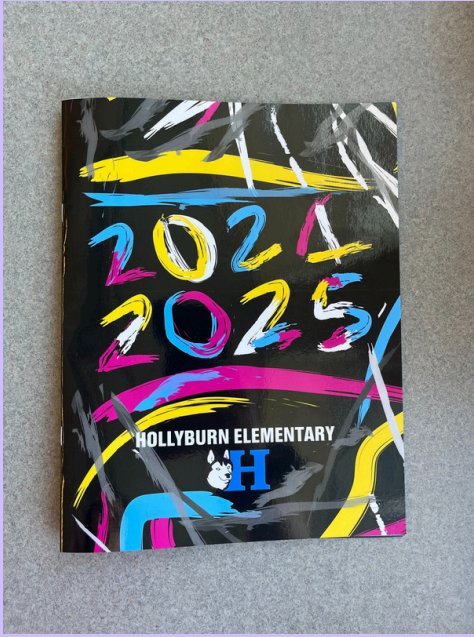
YEARBOOK UPDATE
