
Hollyburn This Week

Highlights, Happenings, and What's Ahead



This past Monday and Tuesday were important days for our school, our community, and our country. On Monday, classes gathered to recognize Orange Shirt Day, honoring the legacy of residential school survivors and the importance of reconciliation, in developmentally appropriate ways. On Tuesday, as part of the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation, I spent time reflecting and listening to the Unrooted Podcast episode titled "Orange" Shirt Day 101: The History, Conversation Starters, and Ways to Create Change." I also spent time outdoors in the sunshine with my son on the traditional, unceded territories of the Skwxwú7mesh (Squamish) Nation, in the area we now call Ambleside. I encourage you to take time with your children to talk about what this week means to them.

Looking ahead, next week is shaping up to be another full one. On Monday, we recognize World Cerebral Palsy Day, a chance to celebrate inclusion and raise awareness for individuals living with cerebral palsy. On Tuesday, our athletes will represent Hollyburn at the final district track meet of the season. Then on Wednesday and Thursday we will host our Fall Intake Conferences. These are essential opportunities to connect with your child's teacher, discuss how the year is progressing, and collaborate on meaningful goals for the months ahead. Please note that students will be dismissed early at 11:10 AM on both Wednesday and Thursday to accommodate these conferences. If you have not yet signed up for a meeting time, please do so using the link provided by your classroom teacher.

I also want to extend a warm invitation to our October PAC meeting, which will take place Tuesday morning at 9:00 AM. I will be sharing my Principal's Report and collaborating with our outstanding Hollyburn PAC team on upcoming initiatives. All parents and guardians are welcome to attend.


