

TROFFIC SOFETY OT HOLLYBURN

This is our second reminder about unsafe driving during drop-off and pick-up. We continue to see cars stopping in unsafe areas and students exiting mid-road — this is dangerous and must stop.


Drop-off is only permitted on Duchess and 13th.
