Before school

- Equipment is to be used only on the field or basketball court
- Use language and behaviour that help everyone feel safe

During school

- Show respect to staff and follow instructions
- Keep hands and feet to yourself
- Move calmly in hallways and shared spaces
- Take care of school equipment and shared materials
- Include others and use kind language
- Solve problems with words and ask an adult for help when needed

These reminders support a positive learning environment and help students stay ready for the exciting activities ahead in December. Thank you for your partnership and for reinforcing these expectations at home. We appreciate your continued support of our community.

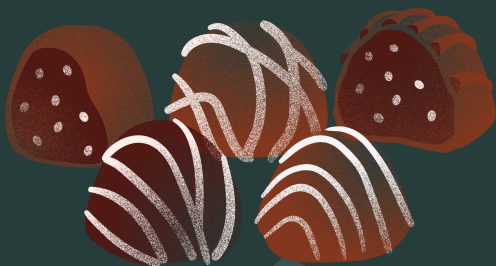

Hollyburn School Visitor and Pickup Protocols



All parents, caregivers, and visitors are to enter the school through the main entrance and report directly to the office upon arrival to sign in.

OFFICE PERSONNEL WILL HANDLE THE DELIVERY OF LUNCHES, COMPUTERS, OR IMPORTANT MESSAGES TO STUDENTS BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 8:50 AM AND 2:50 PM. THIS ENSURES THAT INSTRUCTIONAL TIME IS NOT DISRUPTED.

Dressing for all Weather Conditions

Please ensure your child is dressed for all weather.
