Good evening Husky Families,

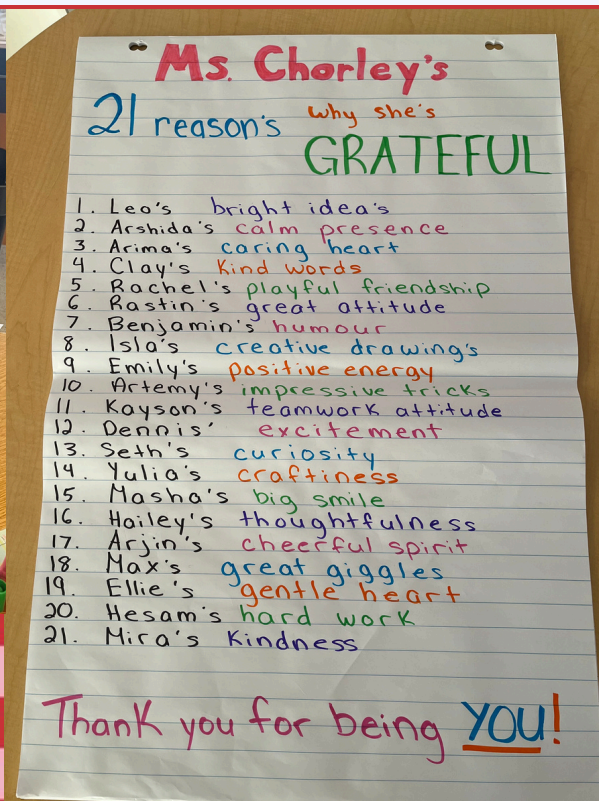
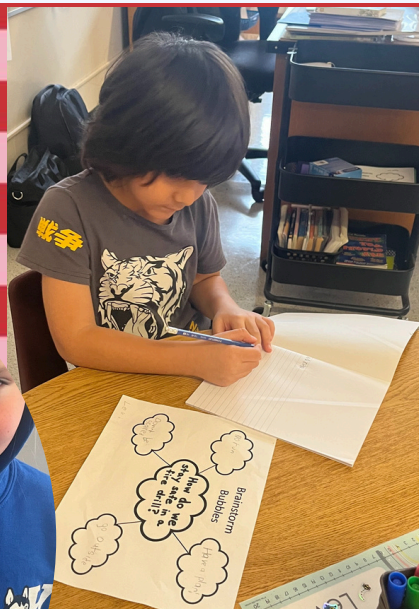

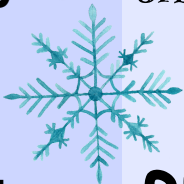
