The 2020 West Vancouver Indigenous Enhancement Agreement (IEA) was developed to guide decision-making that will ensure Indigenous student success. The IEA was developed by the West Vancouver Indigenous Education Advisory Council (WVIEAC).

This agreement commits West Vancouver Schools to continue to develop ongoing partnerships to ensure the success of all First Nations, Métis, and Inuit students attending school in the West Vancouver School District. This Indigenous Enhancement Agreement is a living document that offers direction for the parties, as they work together to provide the finest possible learning opportunities for our students. We strive to work together with mutual respect for one another, and a combined commitment to enhance the educational opportunities and experiences for our students.



GOALS:

To enhance the educational success of our First Nations, Métis, and Inuit students, and focus on three main goals to ensure they are supported intellectually, culturally, and emotionally.

- 1. To use Indigenous ways of Knowing and Perspectives to inform and empower our teaching, learning and decision-making.
- 2. To enhance student success by facilitating transitions and pathways throughout the K-12 Journey.
- 3. To create a sense of space and belonging for Indigenous students that is inclusive to all.
