Where can I seek medical care in Canada?

You can seek medical attention and service anywhere in Canada.

- A Drugstore or Pharmacy can help you find solutions for minor health issues without seeing a doctor.
- Mobile Doctor allows you to connect with a doctor from your phone or computer anytime, anywhere.

- Walk-in Clinics are where you can see a doctor for most health concerns. Visit your local walk-in clinic or go to your GuardMe customized website or www.guard.me and click on, "Find a Canadian Clinic" to see clinics in your area.
- Hospitals are for serious emergencies only.
   Call 911 for emergency assistance. If the hospital asks you to pay, ask for an invoice and submit the invoice to GuardMe.


