It is expected that Irwin Park students have, for example:

- Covered shoulders, sleeveless OK

- Skirts and shorts worn at an appropriate length
- Pants that fit so as not to hang below the hip
- No offensive or inappropriate language or symbols on clothes

Parents are strongly encouraged to take an active interest in monitoring their children's clothing selections and offer guidance to help them make good decisions regarding the clothing they wear to school.

While not included in the above it is also expected that students do not wear hats or hoods within the school building and wear shoes (no beach flip flops) and outerwear appropriate for the weather.
