Principal's Message

It has been a fantastic week of orientation, connection and spirit as our classrooms settle into the school year familiarizing themselves further with routines, expectations while building that all important classroom community. With the Gr 4-7 students beginning to use their devices after spending time together with myself and teachers at our Digital Citizenship assembly, things are starting to take shape more and more. In addition, this week saw our 70 plus strong Cross Country running team brave the elements to compete in their first meet at Ambleside Park. And finally, Irwin Park Panther P.R.I.D.E. was on full display at our Terry Fox Assembly and Run for the Cure on Wednesday afternoon. Thank you so much to the families who donated to the cause by bringing a Toonie for Terry and to those volunteers who helped marshall and cheer on our runners. It's not too late to donate. ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY

As we are beginning our first term, I need to take some time to emphasize the importance of attendance and punctuality. At this time of year most especially, teachers are working hard with classes to build routines and expectations that begin immediately upon the 8:50 am entry bell. Take for example, attendance each morning. Teachers taking student attendance is rarely simply calling a name out loud that most of us grew

up with, but instead a community building opportunity where teachers may ask each student a question to indicate their presence in class, but the responses serve to build important classroom community, trust and ease amongst students. These moments are special and your child's consistent presence as a part of the classroom community is required. As the flu season begins to emerge and illness rates rise, we understand that students who are not fully able to participate in school activities must rest and remain at home until well. This is acceptable and responsible behaviour for every parent.

However, I ask parents to really encourage and support consistent attendance and punctuality with your child so that these habits become the norm in your household and your child is able to get their best start each day; one that is in line with their friends and teachers and our school as a whole. Should you be struggling, please reach out to your child's teacher for consultation and share your concerns or questions. We will be revisiting this topic throughout the year, and I look forward to sharing a letter written by a colleague outlining the impact of school lates and absences on an individual's academic and social emotional growth.

IRWIN PARK HOT LUNCH: Now Open for Orders!

The IPPG is pleased to announce that the Irwin Park MunchAlunch website is open NOW! for hot lunch orders from September 26th to December 22nd.

Lunch orders are delivered to students at the school on **Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday**. Orders must be received by Sunday evening at 6pm for the <u>following</u> week.

We are offering added **flexibility** to the hot lunch program in two main ways. First, the website will remain open so parents can place orders up to 5 days prior to lunch day (e.g. Friday lunch orders close Sunday evening. Secondly, orders can also be customized for each delivery day *(for example: cheese pizza on Oct 5 and pepperoni on Oct 12).*

Orders are made directly through the <u>MunchALunch website</u>. Be sure to order individually for each day you would like your child(ren) to receive a delivered lunch. <u>New users must first register for an account with the **Register Here** button</u>. Online Policy and Procedure Forms Due Now!

Every year, parents are required to complete a new Online Permission Form for each of their children attending a West Vancouver School. Those students with incomplete forms will **not** be able to **use electronic devices in class, access their Google**Classroom, go on walking field trips, plus more. Google Classroom is the platform teachers will use to communicate with their students and parents and in classroom academics at Gr 4-7. Please complete the online permission forms for each of your children by using the following link

If you previously created an account the account is the same. If you have forgotten your password, you can follow the instructions to reset it. If a parent does not have an account, they can create one with the link above. After you have logged in, you have the option to either update a Policies and Procedures Form created last year or start a new one.

- **Step 2:** Register by selecting the "Get Started Now" and following the steps
- **Step 3:** After you receive the confirmation email, select the "click here" option, login in and add each of your children to your household account.

To do this, you will need your student's **PIN number, last name, and date of birth**.
