The IPPG, with the financial support of a very generous anonymous parent donor, is hosting a <u>Welcome Back Carnival Fundraiser</u> on Thurs Sept 26th. This will be held in partnership with our <u>Inside Irwin Park / aka Meet the Teacher</u> afternoon on that same Thursday afternoon this coming week.

Our **Inside Irwin Park** event is similar to last September's event where parents are invited into their child's classroom to familiarize themselves with the classroom space, routines and expectations. Meeting your child's teacher is an important part of a strong educational partnership! At 3:30 pm there will be an ELL Parent Orientation in the library. Following our sessions, the IPPG Welcome Back Carnival will take place on our Gravel Field and in the Gym.

HOT LUNCH – OPEN AND TAKING ORDERS – Deadline for Next Week's Lunches – Sunday Sept 15th

The IPPG is pleased to announce that the <u>MunchALunch website w</u> is OPEN for hot lunch orders for the 2024 Fall Term.

Lunch orders are delivered to students at the school on **Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday**.

We are offering added **flexibility** to the hot lunch program in two main ways. First, the website will remain open so parents can place orders up to 5 days prior to lunch day (e.g. Friday lunch orders close Sunday evening. Secondly, orders can also be customized for each delivery day (for example: cheese pizza on Oct 4 and pepperoni on Oct 12).

Orders are made directly through the <u>MunchALunch website</u>. Be sure to order individually for each day you would like your child(ren) to receive a delivered lunch.
