Public Works Notice: Neighbourhood Traffic Concern

Please see the attached document to inform you of upcoming construction work to <u>upgrade the</u> <u>watermain along Haywood Avenue</u>, <u>between 25th and 26th Street</u>, <u>near Irwin Park Elementary School</u>. **Construction is scheduled to begin on Monday**, **February 3**,2025 and the expected duration is 7-weeks. Haywood Avenue will remain open with a singe-lane alternating traffic and we do not anticipate significant impact on school traffic.
