EDUPAC School Supplies for Sept 2025 – Online Ordering Available Now!

Starting this spring, Irwin Park is moving to an individual school supply ordering system through **EDU PAC**, a trusted Canadian provider. In past years, supplies were bulk-purchased with a flat fee; moving forward, families will order personalized kits online.

Each grade team has carefully refined their supply lists to keep costs purposeful and under \$70. Kits will be delivered directly to the school and ready for students on the first day of school in September. Supply lists and the **online ordering link** and **school password** was shared this past week by Ms. Verdicchio with all returning families via email.

Please note: families are responsible for purchasing their child's kit to help ensure every student is fully prepared for the start of the school year helping teachers to streamline classroom routines and maximize instructional time.
