10 Ideas for Screen Free Time Together w/ Family

- **Family winter walk + “notice 5 things” game**
Go outside together and take turns naming 5 things you notice (sounds, smells, textures, colours). Slow pace, no headphones.
- **Hot chocolate “mindful moment”**
Make a warm drink and do a 2–3 minute pause: breathe, notice the warmth, and share one “good thing” from the day.
- **Shared movie night** with a quick chat after
Pick one family film, watch together, then ask: *What was your favourite part? What would you do in that situation?*
- **Neighbourhood lights walk**
Choose a route, bring a thermos, and let each person pick one house/light display to describe (what they like about it and why).
- **Cook or bake as a team**
Give everyone a role (measure, mix, set the table). Keep it simple and focus on working together, not perfection.
- **Board game / card game “mini-tournament”**
Best of three over a few days. Emphasize good sportsmanship and one compliment to another player after each game.

- **Create a family photo book or slideshow** (short, together)
20–30 minutes: choose favourite photos from the year, add captions, and share the story behind one picture each.
- **Indoor “movement break” challenge**
A 10-minute family circuit (stairs, yoga stretches, dance song, or a follow-the-leader workout). Everyone takes a turn leading.
- **Simple winter nature scavenger hunt**
Look for things like: pinecone, animal tracks, three shades of green, a smooth rock, something that sparkles. Take photos if you want, but keep it moving.
- **Gratitude circle**
Once during the break, at a meal or while relaxing: each person shares one gratitude and one intention for the new term (e.g., “be kinder,” “try harder,” “sleep more”).
