First Day of School

Students in <u>Grades 1-3</u> are welcome back to school on **Tuesday, September 6th.** School will be in session from 8:45 to 9:45 a.m.

Kindergarten students will begin school on Wednesday, September 7th from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. and will follow the gradual entry schedule that has been emailed to parents directly. This district wide appproach to the beginning of Kindergarten allows for extended opportunities for your child to connect with their teacher and classmates in a small, individualized setting. A specific email was sent to all new Kindergarten families at the begging of July outlining assigned attendance dates and specific times for your child's gradual entry.

Health & Safety Reminders

- Please note that wearing a mask is a personal choice as we are a mask friendly school. Either choice will be respected.
- Students will be encouraged to practice strong hand hygiene and will have opportunities to wash their hands or utilize hand sanitizer stations between transitions.
- Under the BCCDC Guidance students should not come to school if they are sick and unable to participate fully in routine activities. Please conduct a health check with your child each morning.
- A health check means a person regularly checking to ensure they (or their child) are not
 experiencing symptoms of illness (including but not limited to COVID-19 symptoms) that
 would limit their ability to participate fully in regular activities before coming to school to
 prevent spread of communicable diseases, such as COVID-19, within school settings.

What To Do When Sick

Staff, students, or other persons who are exhibiting new symptoms of illness (including symptoms of COVID-19 or gastrointestinal illness) should stay home and follow the BCCDC guidance outlined below:

If the person is experiencing COVID-19 symptoms


- The When to Get Tested for COVID-19 resource or the B.C. Self-Assessment Tool provides
 more information on whether you should get a test for COVID-19. Those unsure or
 concerned about their symptoms should connect with a health care provider or call 8-1-1.
- Staff, children, or other persons in the school setting who test positive for COVID-19 should follow the guidance on the BCCDC website as to how long they should self-isolate. They can return to school when they no longer need to self-isolate as long as symptoms have improved, and they are well enough to participate in regular activities. Schools should not require a health care provider note (e.g., a doctor's note) to confirm the health status of any individual, beyond those required to support medical accommodation as per usual practice.
- Students who develop symptoms and/or become sick at school will be isolated and sent home.
