Hot lunch

The Lions Bay School Lunch Program will be starting again with Pizza Day on Tuesdays, Subway Day on Wednesdays, and Sushi Day on Thursdays. We will also have one homemade hot lunch on the last Friday of every month starting. The Lunch Program is not mandatory but is a fundraiser for the school that enables teachers to purchase additional materials they may not otherwise be able to.

Ordering opens on Thursday evening September 22nd, with an <u>order deadline of Sunday</u>
<u>September 24th end of day</u>, for the first week of orders (September 25-29). Order deadline for the remainder of the fall term (September - December) is <u>Saturday September 30th end of day</u>.

Please note that we depend on parent volunteers to pick up lunches from Horseshoe Bay on Tuesdays and Wednesdays and Gleneagles School on Thursdays and deliver them to Lions Bay School. Please consider volunteering if you are available on those days.

This year we are also participating in the BC Agriculture in the Classroom program (www.bcaitc.ca) which delivers fresh fruit or vegetables to school two times per month on Tuesdays. If you do NOT want your child to participate then please let us know as soon as possible and we will provide you with a reverse permission form. The dates when fruit and veg will be delivered in October and November are listed below. Meet the Teacher/Open House

This year we will be holding our **Meet the Teacher/Open House event on Wednesday, September 27**th **at 8:15 a.m.** Please join us to find out about our areas of Inquiry, curriculum, and our classroom expectations. We will host parents inside the school and Grade k to 3 students only will be supervised on the playground (no younger siblings will be supervised on the playground).

Science Workshops

We will have scientists from Science Made Fun visiting the classrooms on **Wednesday, September 27**th after recess. The scientists will engage the children in some fun hands on-workshops on the topic of Matter.

Grade 2/3 - Matter Meltdown

Discover the inside of an atom and explore the different states of matter. Heat things up and cool things down as we find out what makes things sink, how things float, and what really gets matter moving.

Grade K/1 – What's the Matter?

Find out what really matters as we explore the properties of solids, liquids, and gases. Discover what happens when solids and liquids interact during chemical reactions and in our density bottles. Observe for yourself that gases take up space.

Market Garden

Our Grade 3 students will be holding a market garden on Thursday, September 28th at 2:45 p.m. Bring your loonies and toonies for some organic kale and herbs.

Orange Shirt Day Event at Lions Bay will be on Friday, September 29th

Students are invited to wear an orange shirt or something with orange to promote awareness around residential schools and their impact on Indigenous communities in Canada. Students will be engaged in Indigenous stories and activities to learn about Indigenous history.


Student Photo Day – Tuesday, October 3rd. (A message from our photographer)





