Special thanks to Ms. Tsumura and her Grade 2's, Mr. Schofield and Ms. Meldrum's Grade 4 classes and a few specific Grade 4 students, Ms. Swanson's Grade 5 class as well as Ms. Bundic's Grade 2 class. COMMUNICATING STUDENT LEARNING (CSL) TERM 1 REPORT CARD

Our original CSL Term 1 Report Card – set for Friday, December 4th – was determined last May prior to the return to school in September with 100 % in-person for Stage 2. With that we had a delayed start of school with Orientation Week. The staff and I agree that we need to adjust this date back by one week to Friday, December 11th. This allows for more time to get to know your child and make a connection first, more time for teaching and assessment mixed in with all of the new COVID protocols and still leaves a week before we break on Friday, December 18th for Winter Holidays for any concerns from parents.

Please adjust this date for CSL Term 1 Report Cards to the new date of Friday, December 11th, 2020. Teachers will have a choice to complete an online report card (Fresh Grade) or a paper report card (MyEd). If you have any questions – please email Mr. Zerbe directly at wzerbe@wvsschools.ca.

HALLOWE'EN AT RIDGEVIEW 2020

On Friday, October 30th, we will be celebrating Hallowe'en. What we have planned to date is for students to come to school in a costume – elementary appropriate – that is comfortable enough to wear all day. We are not able to manage "in's" and "out's" with costume changes or dropping off costumes. Please plan accordingly. We are also going to do a virtual parade where we will be taking pictures and videos of each classroom in the morning and stitching together a virtual Hallowe'en parade to share with all classes for the afternoon. I hope to share with parents after – but we need all photo permissions approved and completed. If you have not provided these permissions (online Policy & Procedure form) – please attend to this task.

PLAN FOR SCHOOL (GR K-7)

One aspect with so many staggered starts, flipped recess and different lunch times – it's really challenging for students to arrive late or leave early part way through the day. If you have an important appointment – than that may need to take precedent than coming to school that day.

2021/22 KINDERGARTEN AND IN-CATCHMENT GRADES 1-7 REGISTRATION

Do you or someone you know have a child born in 2016? Now is the time to register them for Kindergarten! Admissions applications for the 2021-2022 school year are available on our website here.

ALL Kindergarten students may submit an online application now. Students who will be entering Grades 1-12 and live IN-CATCHMENT may also apply.

Out-of-catchment and out-of-district applications for students entering Grades 1 – 12 in 2021-2022 will be available at 8am on January 15, 2021.

In order to comply with health and safety guidelines, parents and visitors should not enter schools without an appointment, so all supporting documents are being accepted electronically this year.

To complete your application, after you submit the online form, you must send good-quality electronic copies of all required documentation to your first choice school only.

Early French Immersion Kindergarten applications are subject to a placement lottery. For a child to be included in the lottery, applications must be complete before 3pm on Monday, November 30, 2021.

If your child is currently in Grade 7 and your first choice high school is West Vancouver Secondary School, you are not required to complete an online application (regardless of where you live). West Vancouver Secondary School counsellors will be visiting Ridgeview in late winter/early spring and will be distributing transfer forms at that time.

HOWEVER, if your first choice for secondary school is somewhere other than West Vancouver Secondary School (i.e. Sentinel or Rockridge), you must complete an online application according to the <u>student</u> <u>registration timelines</u>. Please note: No out of catchment or out of district applications for secondary schools are accepted until January 15, 2021.
