### **SCHOOL NEWS**

#### **REMEMBRANCE DAY VIRTUAL ASSEMBLY (GR K-7)**

Next week, on November 10<sup>th</sup> at 11:00 am, we are having our Remembrance Day Virtual Assembly for our school. It's a blend of in-person experience and pre-re corded selections that will be experienced

and shared at the same time with each class in their own classroom. We will start with a school wide welcome over the PA, followed by O Canada, where students are invited to "sing" in sign language (ASL), which all students have been working on with Mrs. Soderling in their music classes. Following this introduction, each class will play a video recording of the Remembrance Day Assembly. We have several Grade 7 speakers taking the lead in this



video – Dahlia, Phil, Baran, Xiao, Leo and Sienna. Further to this, contributing classes include the Grade 3's presentation on Afghanistan, the Grade 4's singing Bob Dylan's "Blowin' in the Wind" and the Last Post and the Reveille played by Grade 5 student, Gloria, on trumpet.

On this day all students will be receiving a poppy (poppy stickers for primary grades). We are asking that each child bring a small donation (we suggest \$1 or \$2) for the Royal Canadian Legion poppy campaign. Thank you for your support.

#### LATE ARRIVALS (GR K-7)

It is very important for students to arrive on time. However, if a student does arrive late, they should report to the main entrance front doors to line up. Please do not go directly to your child's classroom door if your child is late as it will be locked. One of our office staff will be at the front door at <u>9:00 am</u> and again at <u>9:15 am</u> to admit late students, supervise hand washing and have them check into the office for a late slip. If your child is arriving late after 9:15 am, parents/guardians must accompany them to the front door and call the office at 604-981-1250 for access.

#### EARLY PICK UPS (GR K-7)

One aspect with so many staggered starts, flipped recess and different lunch times – it's really challenging for teachers and staff when students leave part way through the day. Please plan for school. If you have an important appointment – than that may need to take precedent than coming to school that day. A reminder that there are no "out and in privileges" – it's about limiting exposure. Thank you for your cooperation.

#### **DROPPING OFF ITEMS (GR K-7)**

A reminder that there is no dropping off forgotten items and/or lunches. Be prepared and be sure to have everything when you leave home – water bottle, lunch, planners, school materials and homework. If you forget – you will have to do without. This procedure is in place to support our COVID protocols and limit the number of people on the school grounds.

#### **DRESSING FOR THE WEATHER / EXTRA CLOTHES**

As the temperatures are dropping and the rain is here, please ensure that your child is dressed appropriately for all weather conditions. It is always a very good idea for **all students to have an extra set of clothes and footwear at school** to change into should they get wet and/or muddy.

#### 2021/22 KINDERGARTEN AND IN-CATCHMENT GRADES 1-7 REGISTRATION

Do you or someone you know have a child born in 2016? Now is the time to register them for Kindergarten! Admissions applications for the 2021-2022 school year are available on our website <u>here</u>.

ALL Kindergarten students may submit an online application now. Students who will be entering Grades 1-12 and live IN-CATCHMENT may also apply.

Out-of-catchment and out-of-district applications for students entering Grades 1 - 12 in 2021-2022 will be available at 8am on January 15, 2021.

In order to comply with health and safety guidelines, parents and visitors should not enter schools without an appointment, so all supporting documents are being accepted electronically this year.

To complete your application, after you submit the online form, you must send good-quality electronic copies of all required documentation to your first choice school only.

Early French Immersion Kindergarten applications are subject to a placement lottery. For a child to be included in the lottery, applications must be complete before 3pm on Monday, November 30, 2021.

If your child is currently in Grade 7 and your first choice high school is West Vancouver Secondary School, you are not required to complete an online application (regardless of where you live). West Vancouver Secondary School counsellors will be visiting Ridgeview in late winter/early spring and will be distributing transfer forms at that time. HOWEVER, if your first choice for secondary school is somewhere other than West Vancouver Secondary School (i.e. Sentinel or Rockridge), you must complete an online application according to the <u>student registration timelines</u>. Please note: No out of catchment or out of district applications for secondary schools are accepted until January 15, 2021.
