HALLOWEEN PARADE AT RIDGEVIEW

We are holding our Halloween Parade on Monday, October 31st at 9:00 am.

Our plan has adjusted our route for this event this year. Parents are welcome to view in the following areas:

- Primary parents can have an inside option to view the parade downstairs inside the hallways – please spread out and make room for the primary part of the parade
- Primary parents have an outside option the undercover area as we exit the school to pick up the Grade 2's
- Intermediate parents are welcome to view upstairs around the main lobby area and down the "east wing of upstairs
- Parents of Grade 6/7 band only (due to space) are permitted in the library to watch your child play in the band as the parade walks through the library
- Grade 2 parents only are permitted in the gym to view the Grade 2 performance as emailed to you.

Please take photos of your own children due to photo permission restrictions. Students can come to school dressed and ready to go. Please no scary masks. ALL grades are participating, and we encourage all students to get into the spirit of Halloween. Our hallways are decorated and ready for our event.

Our parade ends in the gym for students only for a brief school assembly. Grade 2 parents only have been invited in for the first part of our gathering for a special grade 2 song performance. We have a limited capacity in the gym and need to be mindful of this and overcrowding the space.

WHAT'S THE PLAN? FOR SAFE ARRIVAL BEFORE & SAFE DEPARTURE AFTER SCHOOL...

With the extended summer ending, please be prepared for the change of season and what this means coming and going from school.

Please arrive earlier in poor weather for students to be dropped off to avoid congestion. We still will be going outside everyday so students need to be properly prepared for the weather at recess and lunch. In saying this – we are encouraging the "Drive and 5" concept of parking a block away and walking in for a few minutes as we simply do not have the capacity for drop-off on Mathers if parents are not actually driving away (Kiss and Go) once dropping of their children. PS - There is lots of parking on Kings to park and walk right onto the field from there.

We have noticed some parents using the parking lot (staff only unless designated by the school) or double parking on 13th – please spread out, arrive early and do not put student safety at risk. Clear sight lines are needed to see our students and please avoid rushing in the area where kids can suddenly appear.

Also – our office hours end at 3:30 pm as students are now dismissed at 2:40 pm. Parents are responsible for their children's care after 2:40pm dismissal. We are open for a little bit in case of an emergency or parents that called in and are arriving late. Doors are locked by 3:15pm. There should be a clear plan for when your child goes home – especially as the time will change and afternoons become dark after 4 pm. We have noticed many students hanging out after school on their devices - when they should be enjoying the outdoors and following the plan home. Our Student Tech User Agreement signed by parents also states that students should not be on District Wi-Fi after school with their devices.

Please arrange accordingly for safe arrival and have a plan for going home after school.

REPORTING STUDENT ABSENCES / LATE ARRIVALS

It is extremely important that student absences/late arrivals be reported to the school office prior to 9:00am by either leaving a voice message on the 'Call Back' phone line at 604-981-1252 or by emailing Mrs. Lytle (slytle@wvschools.ca). Please call or email each day your child is absent or if you know your child will be away for an extended period of time (such as holidays), please email Mrs. Lytle so that this information can be recorded on the Call Back 'long term' form. HOT LUNCH PROGRAM - WHITE SPOT UPDATE FOR OCTOBER 19 LUNCHES

On October 19th White Spot had a mix up with our school order and it resulted in some children having specific menu items substituted.

The wonderful school office staff ensured every child who had placed an order received a hot lunch. They were able to go through the order list and ensure the majority of students received the correct lunch items, however there were a handful of students who had their order substituted with another hot lunch item from White Spot's menu. There were also a few students who may have been shorted a cookie or beverage.

Though every child received a lunch, we are unable to track individually who may have had their order substituted at this time. White Spot has offered to give each child that placed an order for the 19th a coupon for a free pirate pak on their next visit to White Spot. They are very sorry for the confusion, and this was the best way we could ensure there was some sort of compensation for this error. White Spot is typically excellent with their order delivery, but we have connected with their team to try and ensure this doesn't happen again in future.

This week those who ordered lunch on October 19th will receive a coupon to take home with them. You will notice that pirate paks are typically for age 10 and under, however they have put stickers on each at the bottom which will indicate to the server to these are from the school and kids up to Grade 7 can redeem them.

- Follow the on-screen prompts (the system will put all FUTURE lunch dates/selections back into the 'shopping cart': items will appear on the right)
- Go to the date/menu that needs a change
 - Checkmark the item/s you wish to remove
 - Click Remove
 - Add any new items if desired
 - When done, go to the very LAST menu > click Finished > Next > Submit.
 - It's important to RE-SUBMIT your updated order in order for the child to continue receiving lunches and your account to update accordingly.
 - If you removed items, and did not replace them with new items, when you re-submit the system will show a credit in your MunchaLunch account to use for future orders.

If you added more items than originally ordered, please remember to make payment for the new balance after you re-submit your edited order
