CELEBRATING THE LUNAR NEW YEAR – YEAR OF THE RABBIT!

The school is working with a group of parent volunteers to create a special day on Thursday, January 26th to celebrate the Lunar New Year – the Year of the Rabbit. We are hard at work and training. We

will start with a lion dance parade with drummers that parents are able to watch. <u>Here's a teaser</u> on our Twitter account. This will start at 8:45 am in the undercover area by the Grade 3 doors. The lion dance parade will visit each classroom to bless each space and in hopes of bringing prosperity to each room. The lion will be attracted to each classroom by a symbolic head of lettuce that will be exchanged with the lion for a gift for each student. Parents will be able to view the parade in three ideal locations: the Grade 3 undercover area (start), downstairs hallway, upstairs foyer/entrance (end).

It is extremely important that student absences/late arrivals be reported to the school office prior to 9:00am by either leaving a voice message on the '**Call Back' phone line at 604-981-1252** or by emailing Mrs. Lytle (slytle@wvschools.ca). Please call or email <u>EACH</u> day your child is absent or if you know your child will be away for an extended period of time, please email Mrs. Lytle so that this information can be recorded on the Call Back 'long term' form. Also, if you will be extending your winter break holiday beyond January 2nd, please let us know. Thank you for your cooperation.

DISTRICT WEATHER CLOSURES AND PROCEDURES

As winter approaches, the likelihood of school disruptions due to snowfall or power outages increases. As such, we would like to provide you with some important information about the district's weather closure of schools procedures and announcements process.

The district aims to keep schools open on every regular instructional day, including those with snowfall. However, the final decision to send students to school resides with the parent or guardian since they are most familiar with the specific road and weather conditions around their home and community.

Weather Closure of Schools (Outside School Hours)

Any decision to close schools for the safety of children will be made by the Superintendent. Parents, students, and staff will be informed of the Superintendent's decision via: the school district website at www.westvancouverschools.ca and a School Messenger email

We endeavor to communicate this information to parents and staff by 6:00 a.m. on the day of closure.

Weather Closure of Schools (During School Hours)

If weather conditions create a concern for the safety of students returning home, the school principal can decide to dismiss school early after consulting with the Superintendent.

The decision will be communicated to parents and students using the school's normal communication systems.

Student safety is our first priority. Every effort will be made to keep schools open, but parents are encouraged to establish a plan for their children in the event of early dismissal or school closure.

Ordering Deadline

There's a strict **8-day cut-off** for ordering. For example, to order for Wednesday, January 4, orders should be submitted by Tuesday, December 27.

- Orders should be paid in full at the time of ordering
- Cancellations or changes can be made on the system **<u>BEFORE</u>** cut-off
- Credits resulting from cancellations or changes can be used for future lunch dates or fundraisers, they are not automatically refunded to the method of payment

 - Go to: My Account > View My Orders > click 'Edit' next to the order
 - Follow the on-screen prompts (the system will put all FUTURE lunch dates/selections back into the 'shopping cart': items will appear on the right)
 - Go to the date/menu that needs a change > checkmark the item/s you wish to remove/click Remove > Add any new items if desired > when done, go to the very LAST menu > click Finished > Next > Submit.

(It's important to RE-SUBMIT your updated order in order for the child to continue receiving lunches).
