# THE PROUD PRINCIPAL – TRAFFIC SAFETY UPDATE

Starting the week of February 13<sup>th</sup>, we will be out on Mathers Avenue in the Pick Up/Drop Off/ No Parking zone to remind parent drivers that this is an area to keep moving – not for parking your car to watch your child on the playground before school starts and not for waiting for the bell to let your child out when it rains. We have other areas around our school with ample ability to park and wait. This zone is meant to keep going. In working with the District's Bylaw team - we will have new signage that says "Drop & Go" before school as well as Pick Up & Go" after school and we will be doing a "blitz" to educate parents about the purpose of this space. School staff, WVPD and Community Officers will be present to encourage that this zone operates properly. If you as a parent, wish to join

# **DISTRICT WEATHER CLOSURES AND PROCEDURES**

As winter approaches, the likelihood of school disruptions due to snowfall or power outages increases. As such, we would like to provide you with some important information about the district's weather closure of schools procedures and announcements process.

The district aims to keep schools open on every regular instructional day, including those with snowfall. However, the final decision to send students to school resides with the parent or guardian since they are most familiar with the specific road and weather conditions around their home and community.

#### Weather Closure of Schools (Outside School Hours)

Any decision to close schools for the safety of children will be made by the Superintendent. Parents, students, and staff will be informed of the Superintendent's decision via: the school district website at www.westvancouverschools.ca and a School Messenger email

We endeavor to communicate this information to parents and staff by 6:00 a.m. on the day of closure.

#### Weather Closure of Schools (During School Hours)

If weather conditions create a concern for the safety of students returning home, the school principal can decide to dismiss school early after consulting with the Superintendent.

The decision will be communicated to parents and students using the school's normal communication systems.

Student safety is our first priority. Every effort will be made to keep schools open, but parents are encouraged to establish a plan for their children in the event of early dismissal or school closure.

#### **Ordering Deadline**

There's a strict **8-day cut-off** for ordering. For example, to order for Wednesday, January 4, orders should be submitted by Tuesday, December 27.

- We only accept credit card payments
- Orders should be paid in full at the time of ordering
- Cancellations or changes can be made on the system **<u>BEFORE</u>** cut-off
- Credits resulting from cancellations or changes can be used for future lunch dates or fundraisers, they are not automatically refunded to the method of payment

  - Go to the date/menu that needs a change > checkmark the item/s you wish to remove/click Remove > Add any new items if desired > when done, go to the very LAST menu > click Finished > Next > Submit.

(It's important to RE-SUBMIT your updated order in order for the child to continue receiving lunches).
