THE PROUD PRINCIPAL - Do 1 GIVE 2023

<u>Do1Give Day</u> is set for April 27th. This is a global giving event that amplifies the impact of small daily giving around the world on one day! It makes everyone happy and shows how kindness can change the world by giving to others or the environment. On this day or leading up to this date, Ridgeview students will have a chance to give back to the community through an act of giving their time for doing an actionable item that makes this community and world a better place. Many students will include activities that focus on Earth Day for this focus. We are committing to having every Ridgeview student participate, this will make us eligible for a new grant this year from <u>365 Give</u>. Our students could receive a grant for \$365 that we get to decide as a learning community where and how to donate the monies to support a

local fundraiser or non-profit organization. We will be sharing out the action students have taken closer to the date.

PACK IN PACK OUT LUNCH & SNACK WASTE

We have not reviewed this in sometime, but we have noticed that we need to re-promote "Pack In Pack Out" for managing left over lunch and/or lunch waste. Metro Vancouver has introduced a ban sometime ago on the disposal of organics – including food waste and packaged food. This means food waste must be separated from regular garbage. To support this, students are asked to pack out all waste from their snacks and lunches. We have limited capacity to support this at school.

This includes all wrappings and all organic waste. Reusable containers will be necessary to keep waste to a minimum. You may want to have a large Zip Lock bag in your child's backpack for left over hot lunch food and packaging. Please also ensure if your child requires utensils to eat their lunch that you provide a reusable one from home. We do not have extra utensils at the office. Your support is appreciated.

STUDENT LED CONFERENCES – EARLY DISMISSAL 1:00PM

Student Led Conferences is an informal reporting opportunity for students to show their parents what they have been working on and the students are showcasing their efforts to date. These are not parent teacher conferences. Other families will be in the room during the scheduled times.
