SCHOOL NEWS

THE PROUD PRINCIPAL

We celebrated the first day of summer and National Indigenous Peoples Day with the Ridgeview Sports Day. We opened in a drumming circle that represented the four families/teams (Orca, Wolves, Eagles and Ravens) inspired from the indigenous animals represented on the paddles of our canoe located in the Ridgeview foyer. Elder Bucky opened up with the Coast Salish Anthems, the Squamish territorial welcome and involved our teams in song and dance. The Grade 6 leaders did an energetic call and respond with each house team before moving into stations. The Grade 7 tug-of-war was epic with the

teachers jumping in and the balloon toss also got the crowd cheering! Go Dragons! (see Twitter links underlined).

RETURNING TO SCHOOL AFTER SUMMER BREAK

If you are extending the summer break and returning after we begin classes on Tuesday, September 5th, please keep in mind AP 300 Student Registration and Enrollment states that the unconfirmed whereabouts of an absent registered student will be removed from the school register if the student has not returned by 3:00 pm on the Thursday after school opening (September 7th). Our practice is to allow for some discretion but may require return flight ticket info as well as students returning in a reasonable time that accounts for funding from the Ministry. Also, we are experiencing long wait lists due to enrollment pressure to hold seats this year. This will need to be an individual conversation with Mr. Zerbe if you return after opening day.

LIBRARY BOOKS AND TEXTBOOKS

Please ensure all library books and textbooks are returned to the school over the couple of weeks. If families find any "lost" books over the summer break, please bring them to school at the start of the new school year.

SPORTS JERSEYS

A reminder for any students who have not yet returned their sports jerseys for volleyball, basketball, ultimate or track, please return them by next week.

It is very important to inform us if you know your child(ren) will **NOT** be returning to Ridgeview in September for the 2023/24 school year. Please email Mrs. Lytle (slytle@wvschools.ca) as soon as possible as it is important for us to have accurate information regarding enrollment for the upcoming school year. Thank you for your cooperation.

THIRD TERM CSL (REPORTS)

On Thursday, June 29th, your child's Communicating Student Learning (CSL) Report will be published to the MyEd Family Portal as a PDF (will be located on the right-hand side of the homepage under "Published Reports").

We suggest that you try <u>logging into your account</u> prior to June 29th to ensure that you are ready and have access to it for when the reports are published. If you have forgotten your password, simply use your login and click on "forgot password", and you should receive another temporary one (check your spam/junk folder if you do not receive it).

All term report cards, ELL reports and IEP reports will be posted on the Family Portal for the 2022/23 school year <u>until July 31, 2023</u>. Paper copies will not be sent home so It is strongly recommended that you print and/or save your child's reports to your computer as a PDF if you want to maintain access

to it for future reference. A reminder that there are many resources and a FAQ section on the district site HERE.

IF YOUR CHILD WILL BE ABSENT OR ARRIVING LATE FOR SCHOOL

It is extremely important that student absences/late arrivals be reported to the school office prior to 9:00am by either leaving a voice message on the 'Call Back' phone line at 604-981-1252 or by emailing Mrs. Lytle (slytle@wvschools.ca). Please call or email <u>EACH</u> day your child is absent or if you know your child will be away for an extended period of time, please email Mrs. Lytle so that this information can be recorded on the Call Back 'long term' form. Also, if you will be extending your winter break holiday beyond January 2nd, please let us know. Thank you for your cooperation.

PACK IN PACK OUT LUNCH & SNACK WASTE

We have not reviewed this in sometime, but we have noticed that we need to re-promote "Pack In Pack Out" for managing left over lunch and/or lunch waste. Metro Vancouver has introduced a ban some time ago on the disposal of organics – including food waste and packaged food. This means food waste must be separated from regular garbage. To support this, students are asked to pack out all waste from their snacks and lunches. We have limited capacity to support this at school.

This includes all wrappings and all organic waste. Reusable containers will be necessary to keep waste to a minimum. You may want to have a large Zip Lock bag in your child's backpack for left over hot lunch food and packaging. Please also ensure if your child requires utensils to eat their lunch that you provide a reusable one from home. We do not have extra utensils at the office. Your support is appreciated.

LUNCH UTENSILS - PLEASE PACK FROM HOME

A reminder to **pack a reusable fork, spoon or chopsticks from home** should your child require a utensil to eat what they have for their lunch. **This includes if they are receiving hot lunch.** In order to reduce the amount of waste produced, utensils are not provided with hot lunch, and we do not have utensils available in the office.

GRADE 6/7 BAND REGISTRATION FOR 2023-24

Registration for elementary concert band is now open for the 2023-2024 school year. Band is an optional program offered to Grade 6 and 7 students where they learn an instrument to play as a group. MUNCHALUNCH - *IMPORTANT* Year End Information

As we get closer to the end of the school year, we are reviewing accounts and cleaning up our reporting to ensure final fundraising amounts are reconciled and final vendor payments are made. MunchaLunch is used for both the Hot Lunch Program & Fundraisers, therefore it's important that everything is reconciled for the school year end.

If you have a <u>balance owing in your account</u>, you will be receiving reminders from the MunchaLunch system to pay your balance. Please pay the balance in your account by Tuesday, June 20th.

If you currently have a credit in your account, you have until June 20th to use it towards hot lunch purchases After June 20th we will be reviewing the final list of those with credit balances still showing on account.

For credits under \$10- these will be closed out of the system and included in the fundraising total. For credits over \$10- we will work with our provider to facilitate rolling over the credit to use in the next school year. If you are changing schools next year and have a credit over \$10 after June 20th, please email our Ridgeview Lunch email address at ridgeviewlunch@gmail.com.

MunchaLunch closes its ordering system down on June 30th and will not re-open again until the start of the new school year. If you need to download any receipts from this year, you must do so before this date. They WILL NOT be available after that date as the system re-sets and clears out all balances and previous orders to prepare for the new school year.

The hot lunch program at Ridgeview is one of the RPAC's biggest fundraisers. This school year we have raised \$30,000 from the hot lunch program.

The funds are used for a variety of projects and programs that benefit our children. Throughout the 2022/2023 school year the RPAC has used money raised through the hot lunch program to support things such as:

- Multi-week badminton program, All grades
