## HALLOWE'EN PARADE AT RIDGEVIEW (GR K-7)

We are planning on holding our Hallowe'en Parade on Tuesday, October 31st at 9:00 am.

As we approach Halloween, we would encourage all students that even with a "spooky holiday," we wanted to include a reminder to be safe and respectful at school. Costumes should be trauma-sensitive (given world events) and that costumes based on race, culture, religion, gender, trauma, or those that include masks, gore, blood, and weapons are not appropriate. We encourage a good sense of humour and creativity and we have to remember that our youngest students are sensitive to overly gory and scary masks or fake weapons.

IF the weather is good – we will parade outside around the playground and basketball court area on the blacktop area. Parents would be able to spectate at a distance spread out and along where the blue benches are along the edge of this area behind the cones. Please take photos of your own children due to photo permission restrictions. Students can come to school dressed and ready to go. ALL grades are participating and we encourage all students to get into the spirit of Hallowe'en.

IF the weather is bad – we will be parading inside and parents can gather in the gym to view the parade walk through (please not in the school corridors).

IF a teacher is planning on additional Hallowe'en events, they may reach out to the Room Parents for specifics. Teachers may also be messaging families directly if needed.

We hope everyone will have a safe Hallowe'en evening and a reminder that the **next day is a delayed start at 10:30 am for all students**. This late arrival seems to work after a mid-week Hallowe'en evening. There is no loss of instructional time – this is factored into the year schedule.

## HALLOWE'EN BAKE SALE - OCTOBER 31st

The Grade 7 Grad Committee will be doing a Bake Sale on Halloween day (Tuesday Oct 31st). All proceeds will be going towards the Grade 7 grad activities. If your child would like to bring a few dollars to support the fundraiser that would be greatly appreciated. The fundraiser will take place at lunchtime on Halloween. Thank you for your support.

## LUNCH UTENSILS (GR K-7) - REMEMBER TO PACK FROM HOME

A reminder to pack a reusable fork, spoon or chopsticks from home should your child require a utensil to eat what they have for their lunch. This includes if they are receiving hot lunch. In order to reduce the amount of waste produced, **utensils are not provided with hot lunch and we do not have utensils available in the office.**
