#### STUDENT INFORMATION / EMERGENCY FORMS (GR K-7)

All students have received a package of contact/emergency forms that need immediate attention and are to be returned to classroom teachers by tomorrow. Included in the forms

package is the Student Verification Form which is the student information that is in our database. Parents / guardians are required to review this information and note any changes before returning it. In order to keep our records current, we request that any changes in citizenship, custody, or residential information be supported by supporting documentation submitted to the school office (scan/email). This would include respectively: a Canadian citizenship card or passport; legal custody agreement; a purchase / tenancy agreement and utility bill(s). Please contact the school office or Principal if you have any questions.

### WVS 2023 - 2024 Policies And Procedures Online Forms (Gr K-7)

All Ridgeview families are asked to sign off on the District's Policies and Procedures online form <u>each year</u> and for each child, and it can be accessed <u>HERE</u>. Without completion of this form, students may be unable to participate fully in classroom and school activities (Google Classroom, Terry Fox Run). We ask you to complete this information as soon as possible. The form includes:

#### STUDENT ABSENCES / LATE ARRIVALS (GR K-7)

It is extremely important that student absences/late arrivals be reported to the school office prior to 8:40am by leaving a voice message on the '**Call Back' phone line at 604-981-1252** or by emailing Mrs. Lytle (slytle@wvschools.ca). Please call each day your child is absent or if you know your child will be away for an extended period of time (such as holidays), please email the office so that this information can be recorded on the Call Back 'long term' form. Thank you for your cooperation.

#### SCHOOL CASH ONLINE (GR K-7)

Any payments to the school such as for agendas, lost library books or field trips are done online through <u>SchoolCash</u>. Once registered, you will also be able to receive notifications whenever there is a new item for your child that requires payment, so you won't have to worry about missing deadlines. This account only needs to be set up once and it will follow your child year to year even through secondary school.

### STUDENT AGENDAS (GR 1-7)

Ridgeview students in Grades 1-7 are expected to use the Ridgeview student agenda to organize their homework and school activities. Calendar, timetable, policies and procedures and other important information is included within the student agenda. Our REVISED Code of Conduct must be read as a family, signed, cut off and returned to the classroom teacher. The agendas were given to students (in Grades 1-7) yesterday. Please go to <u>SchoolCash Online</u> to pay \$10 for this item.

#### INDIVIDUAL/CLASS/PANORAMIC PHOTO DAY

Mark your calendars - Individual Photo Day will take place on **Thursday, September 28**<sup>th</sup>. We will have class photos as well as the panoramic photo (whole school picture) on this day as well.

#### BICYCLES AND SCOOTERS (GR K-7)

Staying active is really important. To support this, we encourage students and parents to engage in active transportation by coming to school by bicycle, scooter or walking. With families who live farther away, students can be dropped off a few blocks away so they can make their way to school while getting a little exercise. However, as a reminder, students should not be riding, scooting or skateboarding on school grounds between 8:15am and 3:30 pm.
