THE PROUD PRINCIPAL - PERFORMING WINTER/CHRISTMAS CONCERTS

We have been hard at work as staff support our first-year music teacher, Ms. Lambert, to carry out her vision of hosting two winter concert productions this year. Yesterday we held our <u>Grade 4/5 performances "The Colours of Christmas"</u> that began with a land acknowledgment. Then our cast of actors (Santa, Elves, and Fashionistas), led by our lead performers, Nicholas (Santa), and Tara (Fashionista), set the stage for Santa's many wardrobe changes. The classes joined in and the songs were catchy and merry.

Today we are running our K-3 primary concerts "It's Winter at Ridgeview, Charlie Brown!" which puts a modern twist on an old classic with Charlie Brown, Lucy, Snoopy and gang trying to help Charlie Brown find joy this year. Rainbow (Charlie Brown) and Vera (Lucy) led the cast through the storyline while primary classes joined in to sing two songs each.

LUNCH UTENSILS (GR K-7) – REMEMBER TO PACK FROM HOME

A reminder to pack a reusable fork, spoon or chopsticks from home should your child require a utensil to eat what they have for their lunch. This includes if they are receiving hot lunch. In order to reduce the amount of waste produced, **utensils are not provided with hot lunch and we do not have utensils available in the office.**

DISTRICT WEATHER CLOSURES AND PROCEDURES

As winter approaches, the likelihood of school disruptions due to snowfall or power outages increases. As such, we would like to provide you with some important information about the district's weather closure of schools procedures and announcements process.

The district aims to keep schools open on every regular instructional day, including those with snowfall. However, the final decision to send students to school resides with the parent or guardian since they are most familiar with the specific road and weather conditions around their home and community.

Weather Closure of Schools (Outside School Hours)

Any decision to close schools for the safety of children will be made by the Superintendent. Parents, students, and staff will be informed of the Superintendent's decision via: the school district website at www.westvancouverschools.ca and a School Messenger email

We endeavour to communicate this information to parents and staff by 6:00 a.m. on the day of closure.

Weather Closure of Schools (During School Hours)

If weather conditions create a concern for the safety of students returning home, the school principal can decide to dismiss school early after consulting with the Superintendent. The decision will be communicated to parents and students using the school's normal communication systems.

Student safety is our first priority. Every effort will be made to keep schools open, but parents are encouraged to establish a plan for their children in the event of early dismissal or school closure.

KUNG-FU KIDS AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM AT RIDGEVIEW (JANUARY 2024)!

Looking for an after-school program that helps your child develop speed, power, balance and coordination-- as well as gain practical skills in self-defence while having fun? Kung-Fu Kids is

finally here on Thursdays after school at Ridgeview (in the gym) starting in January! We have 2 programs available on Thursdays:

Grades K-2: 2:45pm-3:25pm (40 minutes) - Using music, games, storytelling, and kung-fu patterns (basic kicking and punching) to learn about balance, coordination, reaction, and timing to develop better focus, listening, and gross motor function skills.

Fee: \$15/class (Thursdays, January 11 - March 7, total 9 classes).

Grades 3-7: 3:30pm-4:45pm (75 minutes) - We will begin with a general warm-up, proper stretching, body conditioning and fundamental self-defence techniques in kicking, striking, blocking, and stances/footwork. The main goal is to develop speed, accuracy and power. We will use various modern conditioning and sports equipment, as well as safety gear such as mats, striking pads and kicking shields.

Level 1 Grade testing and certification is available, but optional.

Fee: \$20/class (Thursdays, January 11-March 7, total 9 classes).
