CELEBRATING NOWRUZ 2024 FRIDAY, MARCH 15TH

In working with an organizing parent committee, Ridgeview is set to celebrate Nowruz 2024 tomorrow Friday, March 15th all day. Our plans will start for families before school in our gym at 8:25 am (come for an early drop off and park) for a 10-minute performance of traditional music and dance to reign in Nowruz. Our Superintendent Kennedy will be joining us for this opening aspect of the day. At 8:40 am when the bell goes, students will go to class to begin a day of activities supported by parents and Grade 7 students. Each grade cohort will enjoy three stations in the library engaging in traditional aspects of Nowruz. At 12:55 pm we will have an assembly with an opening video explaining Nowruz and the Half-Sin table followed by a performance of traditional music. Students are welcome to wear traditional dress or Spring colours.

SECOND TERM LEARNING UPDATE (REPORT) - YOUR MYED FAMILY PORTAL

Tomorrow, March 15th, your child's Learning Update (Report) will be published to the MyEd Family Portal as a PDF (will be located on the right-hand side of the page under "Published Reports").

As the office will be closed for Spring Break after tomorrow, we suggest that you try logging into your account now to ensure that you are ready and have access to it for when the reports are published. If you have forgotten your password, simply use your login and click on "forgot password", and you should receive another temporary one (check your spam/junk folder if you do not receive it).

All term reports for the 2023/24 school year will be posted on the Family Portal **until July 31, 2024**. Paper copies **will not** be sent home, so it is strongly recommended that you print and/or save your child's reports to your computer as a PDF if you want to maintain access to it for future reference.

A reminder that there are many resources and a FAQ section on the district site HERE. Should you require further assistance, please email Mrs. Lytle (slytle@wvschools.ca), but please note that the office is closed during Spring Break (March 16 – April 1).

FAMILIES ARE ADVISED TO CHECK IMMUNIZATION RECORDS BEFORE SPRING BREAK TRAVEL

With measles outbreaks being reported internationally and spring break on the horizon, the provincial health officer, BC Centre for Disease Control and public health officials are reminding people in British Columbia to check their vaccination records before travelling to ensure they are protected. DRESS FOR THE WEATHER / CHANGE OF CLOTHES AT SCHOOL (GR K-7)

We have had an increasing number of students coming in from recess or lunch wet and/or muddy. Please ensure your child is prepared for wet weather with proper outerwear and footwear. **Please also ensure they have an extra set of clothes (including socks/shoes) at school should they get wet and/or muddy during the school day.** We believe in a <u>West Coast Recess and Lunch</u> and we encourage students to be ready for all weather conditions.

LUNCH UTENSILS – REMEMBER TO PACK FROM HOME

A reminder to pack a reusable fork, spoon or chopsticks from home should your child require a utensil to eat what they have for their lunch. This includes if they are receiving hot lunch. In order to reduce the amount of waste produced, **utensils are not provided with hot lunch and we do not have utensils available in the office.**
