STUDENT PLACEMENT INPUT REQUEST FOR 2024/2025 (GR K-6)

Our class placement process ensures that thoughtful consideration of each child's social, emotional and academic needs is aligned with the need to create balanced and effective learning environments. The assignment of students to classes is decided by a team, which includes the School Based Resource Team, a child's current teacher, non-enrolling teachers, support staff and the administrators. This professional team considers each placement carefully as they create classes that include a wide range of students who learn in a variety of ways.

The driving factor that determines organization in the public school system is based on enrollment. West Vancouver School District's priority is space at each grade where possible for students to have an opportunity to attend their catchment school and/or priority choice. This is the reason Ridgeview has moved towards "multi-age classes" (otherwise known as split classes or combined classes) as have other schools in West Vancouver Schools.

Parents – please consider only making a request if there are extenuating circumstances OR to share information you feel should be considered when placing their child for the next school year.

To make a request – **please fully read the attached letter** which outline information and guidelines for making a request with the Input Form. Please submit any **Input Forms** to Mr. Zerbe (wzerbe@wvschools.ca) and "cc" your child's current classroom teacher.

Input Forms are due no later than May 17th – late requests cannot be honoured.

PRIMARY KILOMETER CLUB (GR K-3)

Every Tuesday and Thursday morning, starting April 30th until June 20th, we will be running a Primary KM Club. Staff will be on hand to run the club and supervise students in Grades K-3 who would like to

participate. This is an opportunity for Primary students to get their daily physical activity in a fun, noncompetitive setting while practicing perseverance, building endurance and challenging themselves!

We will meet on the gravel field at 8:10-8:35 weather permitting (if it is raining – don't come). Students can walk, jog or run laps of the field and collect a popsicle stick for each lap (3 laps = 1 KM). It is the student's responsibility to hold onto their sticks. Classroom teachers will help the students to track their progress. Ribbons will be awarded for those who run 10, 25 or 50 KM.

Parents are welcome and encouraged to stay and cheer the runners on!

Please note: Do not drop your Primary child at the field early as there will only be supervision for runners between 8:10 and 8:35 and participants must stay on the field for the whole time.

KUNG-FU KIDS AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM AT RIDGEVIEW

Kung-Fu Kids Spring 2024 Session @ Ridgeview (Thursdays) Our spring class is now in session -- spots still available, late sign-ups are okay!

Still looking for an after-school program that helps your child develop speed, power, balance and coordination-- as well as gain practical skills in self-fence while having fun? Kung-Fu Kids is resuming sessions this spring! We have 2 programs available on Thursdays:

Grades K-2: 2:45pm-3:25pm (40 minutes) - Using music, games, storytelling, and kung-fu patterns (basic kicking and punching) to learn about balance, coordination, reaction, and timing to develop better focus, listening, and gross motor function skills.
