SCHOOL NEWS

THE PROUD PRINCIPAL— CHOIR AND A PANCAKE BREAKFAST

If you are looking for an awesome place to go to school – Ridgeview Elementary is it! We have an <u>amazing Grade 4/5 choir led by Ms. Lambert</u> with all of her passion for music and song! The students are so pumped to sing songs like "Believer" by *Imagine Dragons;* therefore, we got a big turn out! We also celebrated 3 years of building a sense of belonging at Ridgeview, culminating in <u>a pancake</u>

<u>breakfast for buddy classes</u>. The RPAC sponsored this in working with Little Kitchen Academy in North Vancouver to bring this to fruition. Our Grade 7's took the lead in preparing, cooking and serving 400 students and staff!

SPORTS DAY JUNE 19 & EARLY DISMISSAL @ 1:00 PM

Sports day is coming to you next week, Wednesday, June 19th – rain or shine! Students have been put into Indigenous colour /animal teams and will be challenging each other in pep rally chants and relay/station competitions. The Grade 6's will be team captains and the Grade 7's will be running the stations supervised and encouraged by staff. We wrap up the morning with the traditional Grade 7 balloon toss and tug-of-war challenge. Students should come prepared to be outside (hats, sunscreen, water bottle) and dress in their team colours (teachers will inform the students). All of this takes place in the morning and the RPAC will offer a Freezie snack. Parents are welcome to come out and watch. Students will have a regular lunch hour and then come inside for a few minutes before being dismissed at 1:00 pm (early dismissal)

LIBRARY BOOKS AND TEXTBOOKS

Please ensure all library books and textbooks are returned to the school over the couple of weeks. If families find any "lost" books over the summer break, please bring them to school at the start of the new school year.

SPORTS JERSEYS

A reminder for any students who have not yet returned their sports jerseys for volleyball, basketball, ultimate or track, please return them (washed) by Monday.

WATER BOTTLES, HATS, SUNSCREEN

Summer weather is starting to arrive, and we are asking students to be prepared for the hotter weather. Please apply sunscreen before the school day and have your child bring a hat. Most importantly ensure your child has a filled water bottle.

SUMMARY OF LEARNING (REPORTS)

On Thursday, June 27th, your child's Summary of Learning Report will be published to the MyEd Family Portal as a PDF (will be located on the right-hand side of the homepage under "Published Reports").

We suggest that you try <u>logging into your account</u> prior to June 27th to ensure that you are ready and have access to it for when the reports are published. If you have forgotten your password, simply use your login and click on "forgot password", and you should receive another temporary one (check your spam/junk folder if you do not receive it).

All Learning Updates #1 and #2, the final Summary of Learning Report, ELL reports (AIPs) and IEP reports will be posted on the Family Portal for the 2023/24 school year **until July 31, 2024**. **Paper copies will not be sent home**, so it is strongly recommended that you print and/or save your child's reports to your computer as a PDF if you want to maintain access to it for future reference. A reminder that there are many resources and a FAQ section on the district site <u>HERE</u>.

RETURNING TO SCHOOL AFTER SUMMER BREAK

If you are extending the summer break and returning after we begin classes on Tuesday, September 3rd, please keep in mind <u>AP 300 Student Registration and Enrolment</u> states that the unconfirmed whereabouts of an absent registered student will be removed from the school register if the student has not returned by 3:00 pm on the Thursday after school opening (September 5th). We are experiencing long wait lists due to enrolment pressure to hold seats this year and school and district operations and planning will take priority over travel plans. Please reach out to Mr. Zerbe if you need more information or would like to review your intentions.

It is very important to inform us if you know your child(ren) will **NOT** be returning to Ridgeview in September for the 2024/25 school year. Please email Mrs. Lytle (slytle@wvschools.ca) as soon as possible as it is important for us to have accurate information regarding enrollment for the upcoming school year. A reminder to pack a reusable fork, spoon or chopsticks from home should your child require a utensil to eat what they have for their lunch. This includes if they are receiving hot lunch. In order to reduce the amount of waste produced, **utensils are not provided with hot lunch and we do not have utensils available in the office.**
