SCHOOL NEWS

THE PROUD PRINCIPAL – HALLOWEEN AT RIDGEVIEW

We are planning on holding our Halloween Parade on Thursday, October 31st at 9:00 am.

As we approach Halloween, we would encourage all students that even with a "spooky holiday," we wanted to include a reminder to be safe and respectful at school. Costumes should be traumasensitive (given world events) and costumes based on race, culture, religion, gender, trauma, or those that include masks, gore, blood, and weapons are not appropriate. We encourage a good sense of humour and creativity, and we have to remember that our youngest students are sensitive to overly gory and scary masks or fake weapons.

We will be parading inside and outside by the undercover areas. Parents can gather in the hallways to view the parade walk through or outside by the undercover areas (by the Grade 3 door as well as the kindergarten door). We will host an assembly afterwards for students only due to limited space. Only Grade 6/7 Band parents and Grade 2 parents can attend the assembly to see their child perform.

If a teacher is planning on additional Halloween events, they may reach out to the Room Parents for specifics. Teachers may also be messaging families directly if needed.

We hope everyone will have a safe Halloween evening and a reminder that the **next day** (November 1st) is a delayed start at 10:30 am for all students. This late arrival seems to work after a mid-week Halloween evening. There is no loss of instructional time – this is factored into the year schedule.

HALLOWEEN DANCE AT RIDGEVIEW SPONSORED BY RPAC

We are excited to share news about our first **Ridgeview Halloween Dance** event on **October 30th.** The dance will feature a live DJ with snacks, and glow props available for purchase.

The event is divided into two time slots: **Kindergarten to Grade 4** students from <u>4:30-6:00pm</u>, and **Grade 5 to Grade 7** students from <u>6:30-8:00pm</u>. We encourage all students to <u>attend with a parent or guardian</u>. Tickets can be pre-purchased on <u>Munch a Lunch</u> for \$3 per attendee. This will help us better plan for the event.

PLEASE – NO GUM AT SCHOOL

Parents – we need your help! Please do not send gum with your child to school. This is an expectation and has been communicated previously. It is highly distracting when we engage with students and we are finding gum attached to desks, water fountains and furniture as we have zero means to dispose of it. If we see a child chewing gum – we will ask them to put it in a paper towel and to bring home in their lunch, etc. (as we are pack lunch in/ pack lunch out). STUDENT ABSENCES / LATE ARRIVALS / EARLY PICK UPS (GR K-7)

It is extremely important that student absences/late arrivals be reported to the school office BEFORE 9:00am by leaving a voice message on the '**Call Back' phone line at 604-981-1252** or by emailing Mrs. Lytle (slytle@wvschools.ca). Please call each day your child is absent or if you know your child will be away for an extended period of time (such as holidays), please email the office so that this information can be recorded on the Call Back 'long term' form.

Also, although we discourage the disruption of students being picked up during class time, we understand it is sometimes necessary. Should you require to pick your child up early, it is always best to email their teacher (and copy the office) in advance so that they are aware. Thank you for your cooperation.

INDIVIDUAL PHOTO ORDERS / PHOTO RETAKES (GR K-7)

Students who had their photo taken earlier this month will have now come home with a photo proof which includes instructions on how to order photos should you choose to. Please note that the ordering deadline is TODAY, October 24th. If your child missed the original photo date or should you wish your child's photo to be retaken, please be sure your child knows to have their photo taken on November 6th.

DRESS FOR THE WEATHER (GR K-7)

We have been so fortunate to have such amazing weather so far but more typical Fall weather is upon us. Please ensure your child is prepared to go outside in all weather conditions. It is also a very good idea to have a set of extra clothes (including socks/shoes) at school should your child get wet and/or muddy during the day. Hoodies and/or down jackets are great on cooler days – but not effective in the rain. Please make sure your child can stay dry in the rain, from jackets to footwear. REGISTRATION FOR ALL KINDERGARTEN & IN-CATCHMENT ONLY GR 1-12 FOR 2025-26 SCHOOL YEAR IS NOW OPEN!

If you, or anyone you know, has a child born in 2020, please note that registration for Kindergarten 2025/26 is now open. Registration is also open for any **in-catchment** families with children going

into Grades 1-12. The online registration application can be found here. **Please note out of** catchment Grade 1-7 registrations are not accepted until January 15, 2025.

If your child is going into Grade 8 and your first-choice high school is the one that your school feeds into (Ridgeview's feeder high school is West Vancouver Secondary), you are not required to complete an online application (regardless of where you live). WVSS school counsellors will be visiting Ridgeview in early spring and distributing transfer/course selection forms at that time.

HOWEVER, if your first choice for secondary school is somewhere other than WVSS, you must complete an online application according to <u>admissions timelines</u> (Oct 15th for in-catchment / Jan 15th for out of catchment).
