If you, or anyone you know, has a child born in 2020, please note that registration for Kindergarten 2025/26 opens at 8:00am, Monday October 16<sup>th</sup>. Registration also opens at this time for any **incatchment** families with children going into Grades 1-7. The online registration application can be found here after 8:00am on October 15<sup>th</sup>. Please note out of catchment Grade 1-7 registrations and out of district applications for secondary schools are not accepted until January 15, 2025.

#### DRESS FOR THE WEATHER (GR K-7)

We have been so fortunate to have such amazing weather so far but more typical Fall weather will be upon us soon. Please ensure your child is prepared to go outside in all weather conditions. It is also a very good idea to have a set of extra clothes (including socks/shoes) at school should your child get wet and/or muddy during the day.
