THE PROUD PRINCIPAL - WINTER CONCERTS

The Ridgeview team is excited to rally behind our music teacher, Ms. Lambert, to bring you not just one, but several winter concerts! This takes a lot of effort on behalf of students and staff. To support these efforts, students need to attend **both** the matinee and evening concerts for the performances to be consistent in quality.

We will have a K - 3 Primary Winter Concert. Showtimes:

- Thursday, Dec. 12 @ 1:30 pm Matinee
- Thursday, Dec. 12 @ 6:30 pm Evening

We will have a Gr. 4 – 7 Intermediate Winter Concert. Showtimes:

- Tuesday, Dec. 17 @ 1:30 pm Matinee
- Tuesday, Dec. 17 @ 6:30 pm Evening

Tickets will be limited due to a maximum capacity of 250 (fire code) for each concert. There will be two tickets issued per family. There will be a ticket preference survey emailed to you on Tuesday, November 26th at 9:00 AM. There will be an intermediate survey and a primary survey. The survey will close on Friday, November 29th at 9:00 AM. This is time stamped and will determine if we can accommodate your priority preference. Once a concert time fills up, you may be given tickets of for your non-preference choice. Tickets will be issued shortly after the survey indicating Matinee or Evening. If we have space remaining, grandparents can inquire at the office closer to the date.

We will also have a Gr. 6 & 7 Band Concert. Showtimes:

• Thursday, Dec. 19 @ 1:30 pm. No tickets – but open for Band parents only.

Learning Update reports (Report Cards) will be online and will be accessed through the provincial MyEd BC Family Portal the afternoon of December 6th. The Reports will be found on the right-hand side of the homepage under "Published Reports" as a PDF. A reminder that the reports remain on the portal until July 31st so please download/save/print for future reference. Paper copies of reports will not be going home. We suggest that you try logging into your account now to ensure that you are ready and have access to it for when the reports are published. If you have forgotten your password, simply use your login and click on "forgot password", and you should receive another temporary one (check your spam/junk folder if you do not receive it). All new families were sent information on how to set up your account (with your child's pupil number) on November 6th. STUDENT ABSENCES / LATE ARRIVALS / EARLY PICK UPS / WINTER HOLIDAYS

It is extremely important that student absences/late arrivals be reported to the school office BEFORE 9:00am by leaving a voice message on the 'Call Back' phone line at 604-981-1252 or by emailing Mrs. Lytle (slytle@wvschools.ca). Please call each day your child is absent or if you know your child will be away for an extended period of time (such as holidays), please email the office so that this information can be recorded on the Call Back 'long term' form.

If you are planning on extending the winter holiday break by either leaving before December 20th or arriving after January 6th, please email Mrs. Lytle (slytle@wvschools.ca) as soon as possible so that we may record it for attendance purposes.

Also, although we discourage the disruption of students being picked up during class time, we understand it is sometimes necessary. Should you require to pick your child up early, it is always best to email their teacher (and copy the office) in advance so that they are aware. Thank you for your cooperation.

LUNCH UTENSILS - REMEMBER TO PACK FROM HOME (GR K-7)

A reminder to pack a reusable fork, spoon or chopsticks from home should your child require a utensil to eat what they have for their lunch. This includes if they are receiving hot lunch. In order to reduce the amount of waste produced, utensils are not provided with hot lunch and we do not have utensils available in the office.

WINTER CLOTHING (GR K-7)

Appropriate clothing for winter includes clothing for wet weather – such as rubber boots or "outside shoes", "inside shoes," rain jacket, spare socks, even a spare t-shirt and pants – and cold weather – like extra socks, sweater, toque, and mittens. It is possible that your child will be at school during an earthquake or power outage and may, therefore, be in an unheated building (or even outside in the event of an earthquake) for a long period of time so warm clothing is essential. Students should be prepared to be outside every day.

School Closure Procedures – Opt In to Receive SMS (Gr K-7)

School closures are communicated by our <u>District Website</u>, radio (CBC, CKNW, etc.), and a direct district email to all parents, usually by 6 AM. We may also send text messages for urgent communications, and we encourage you to opt in. For parents/guardians who would like to be notified of a school emergency such as power outages, severe weather or safety alerts via SMS, please text a "Y" or "Yes" to 978338 to ensure you are on the list. Thank you for staying tuned to email when weather has the potential to impact school operations.

DISTRICT WEATHER CLOSURES AND PROCEDURES (GR K-7)

As winter approaches, the likelihood of school disruptions due to snowfall or power outages increases. As such, I would like to provide you with some important information about the district's weather closure of schools procedures and announcements process.

The district aims to keep schools open on every regular instructional day, including those with snowfall. However, the final decision to send students to school resides with the parent or guardian since they are most familiar with the specific road and weather conditions around their home and community.

Weather Closure of Schools (Outside School Hours)

Any decision to close schools for the safety of children will be made by the Superintendent. Parents, students, and staff will be informed of the Superintendent's decision via:

the school district website at www.westvancouverschools.ca and a School Messenger email

We endeavour to communicate this information to parents and staff by 6:00 a.m. on the day of closure.

Weather Closure of Schools (During School Hours)

If weather conditions create a concern for the safety of students returning home, the school principal can decide to dismiss school early after consulting with the Superintendent.

The decision will be communicated to parents and students using the school's normal communication systems.

Student safety is our first priority. Every effort will be made to keep schools open, but parents are encouraged to establish a plan for their children in the event of early dismissal or school closure.

REGISTRATION FOR ALL KINDERGARTEN & IN-CATCHMENT ONLY GR 1-12 FOR 2025-26 SCHOOL YEAR IS NOW OPEN!

If you, or anyone you know, has a child born in 2020, please note that registration for Kindergarten 2025/26 is now open. Registration is also open for any **in-catchment** families with children going into Grades 1-12. The online registration application can be found here. **Please note out of catchment Grade 1-7 registrations are not accepted until January 15, 2025.**

If your child is going into Grade 8 and your first-choice high school is the one that your school feeds into (Ridgeview's feeder high school is West Vancouver Secondary), you are not required to complete an online application (regardless of where you live). WVSS school counsellors will be visiting Ridgeview in early spring and distributing transfer/course selection forms at that time.

HOWEVER, if your first choice for secondary school is somewhere other than WVSS, you must complete an online application according to <u>admissions timelines</u> (Oct 15th for in-catchment / Jan 15th for out of catchment).
