THE PROUD PRINCIPAL – REMEMBRANCE DAY AT RIDGEVIEW

Tomorrow, Friday, November 8th at 11:00 am, our students will view and participate in an assembly emceed by our Grade 7. There will be several student presentations including recognizing Indigenous Veterans Day (Nov. 8th), Canadian Experiences in War, the song *Remembrance Day Child*, Highway of Heroes, *In Flanders Fields* and a Moment of Silence, to remember Canadian Soldiers who made the greatest sacrifice. Our special guest expected for tomorrow is Trustee Zhu and veteran Sergeant Bill Woods. If your child participates in cadets, girl guides, scouts etc., they are welcome to wear their uniform tomorrow for the assembly.

Poppies will be handed out after recess prior to our Remembrance Day event. We are collecting money for poppies and students are encouraged to bring a donation.

Please remember – there is no school on Monday, November 11th for Remembrance Day, as well as no school on Tuesday, November 12th (Pro-D Day).

GLOVE, TOQUE & SOCK DRIVE (GR K-7)

STUDENT ABSENCES / LATE ARRIVALS / EARLY PICK UPS (GR K-7)

It is extremely important that student absences/late arrivals be reported to the school office BEFORE 9:00am by leaving a voice message on the '**Call Back' phone line at 604-981-1252** or by emailing Mrs. Lytle (slytle@wvschools.ca). Please call each day your child is absent or if you know your child will be away for an extended period of time (such as holidays), please email the office so that this information can be recorded on the Call Back 'long term' form.

Also, although we discourage the disruption of students being picked up during class time, we understand it is sometimes necessary. Should you require to pick your child up early, it is always best to email their teacher (and copy the office) in advance so that they are aware. Thank you for your cooperation.

DRESS FOR THE WEATHER (GR K-7)

We have been so fortunate to have such amazing weather so far but more typical Fall weather is upon us. Please ensure your child is prepared to go outside in all weather conditions. It is also a very good idea to have a set of extra clothes (including socks/shoes) at school should your child get wet and/or muddy during the day. Hoodies and/or down jackets are great on cooler days – but not effective in the rain. Please make sure your child can stay dry in the rain, from jackets to

LUNCH UTENSILS – REMEMBER TO PACK FROM HOME (Gr K-7)

A reminder to pack a reusable fork, spoon or chopsticks from home should your child require a utensil to eat what they have for their lunch. This includes if they are receiving hot lunch. In order to reduce the amount of waste produced, **utensils are not provided with hot lunch and we do not have utensils available in the office.**

REGISTRATION FOR ALL KINDERGARTEN & IN-CATCHMENT ONLY GR 1-12 FOR 2025-26 SCHOOL YEAR IS NOW OPEN!

If you, or anyone you know, has a child born in 2020, please note that registration for Kindergarten 2025/26 is now open. Registration is also open for any **in-catchment** families with children going into Grades 1-12. The online registration application can be found here. **Please note out of catchment Grade 1-7 registrations are not accepted until January 15, 2025.**

If your child is going into Grade 8 and your first-choice high school is the one that your school feeds into (Ridgeview's feeder high school is West Vancouver Secondary), you are not required to complete an online application (regardless of where you live). WVSS school counsellors will be visiting Ridgeview in early spring and distributing transfer/course selection forms at that time.

HOWEVER, if your first choice for secondary school is somewhere other than WVSS, you must complete an online application according to <u>admissions timelines</u> (Oct 15th for in-catchment / Jan 15th for out of catchment).
