WINTER/CHRISTMAS CONCERTS

The Ridgeview team is excited to rally behind our music teacher, Ms. Lambert, to bring you not just one, but several winter concerts! This takes a lot of effort on behalf of students and staff. To support these efforts, students need to attend **both** the matinee and evening concerts for the performances to be consistent in quality.

We will have a K - 3 Primary Winter Concert. Showtimes:

- Thursday, Dec. 12 @ 1:30 pm Matinee
- Thursday, Dec. 12 @ 6:30 pm Evening

We will have a Gr. 4 – 7 Intermediate Winter Concert. Showtimes:

- Tuesday, Dec. 17 @ 1:30 pm Matinee
- Tuesday, Dec. 17 @ 6:30 pm Evening

We have a few tickets for the evening performance available and many for the matinee. Tickets are now open to everyone and are first come first served at the office.

GRADE 6 & 7 BAND PERFORMANCE

We are working towards our Grade 6 & 7 band concert on Thursday, December 19th at 1:30 pm. Parents of these band students are welcome to join us in the gym for this assembly (no tickets required).

KUNG FU KIDS WINTER 2025

Looking for an after school program that helps your child develop speed, power, balance and coordination-- as well as gain practical skills in self-defense while having fun? Kung-Fu Kids is resuming sessions this winter!

WHATS INCLUDED: Kung-Fu Kids mentorship chat group with online video lessons and tip sheets for both parents and students to watch and train at home, anytime. All students will get a free red silk sash as their uniform and will be taught how to tie one securely, to be worn during class & at performances.

WHATS NEW: Our academy has rolled out a report card and grading system so students and parents know their progress and can set goals on how to 'Level Up' their skills. We also have a points reward program that students earn for completing physical literacy and kung-fu challenges each week. They can then use the points to redeem prizes such as custom stickers, sports gear, and even movie passes! Note: The bigger the prize, the harder the challenges to be earned over one or more sessions.

We have 2 programs available on Thursdays:

Grades K-2: 2:45pm-3:25pm (40 minutes) - Using music, games, storytelling, and essential kung-fu patterns (basic kicks, blocks and punches) to learn about balance, coordination, reaction, and timing to develop better focus, listening, and gross motor function skills. Kids will also learn about respect, communication & understanding among their peers. Certification and graduation will be held on the last day of class. Fee: \$16/class + GST

Grades 3-7: 3:30pm-4:45pm (75 minutes) - We will begin with a general warm-up, proper stretching, body conditioning and fundamental self-defense techniques in kicking, striking, blocking, and stances/footwork. The main goal is to develop speed, accuracy and power. We will use various modern conditioning and sports equipment, as well as safety gear such as mats, striking pads and kicking shields. Skills and knowledge testing and certification will be conducted on the last day of class. Fee: \$21/class + GST

STUDENT ABSENCES / LATE ARRIVALS / EARLY PICK UPS/ WINTER HOLIDAYS

It is extremely important that student absences/late arrivals be reported to the school office BEFORE 9:00am by leaving a voice message on the '**Call Back' phone line at 604-981-1252** or by emailing Mrs. Lytle (slytle@wvschools.ca). Please call each day your child is absent or if you know your child will be away for an extended period of time (such as holidays), please email the office so that this information can be recorded on the Call Back 'long term' form. Also, although we discourage the disruption of students being picked up during class time, we understand it is sometimes necessary. Should you require to pick your child up early, it is always best to email their teacher (and copy the office) in advance so that they are aware.

If you are planning on extending the Winter Break by either leaving before December 20th or arriving after January 6th, please email Mrs. Lytle (slytle@wvschools.ca) as soon as possible so that we may record it for attendance purposes.

LUNCH UTENSILS (GR K-7) – REMEMBER TO PACK FROM HOME

A reminder to pack a reusable fork, spoon or chopsticks from home should your child require a utensil to eat what they have for their lunch. This includes if they are receiving hot lunch. In order to reduce the amount of waste produced, **utensils are not provided with hot lunch and we do not have utensils available in the office.**

DISTRICT WEATHER CLOSURES AND PROCEDURES

As winter approaches, the likelihood of school disruptions due to snowfall or power outages increases. As such, we would like to provide you with some important information about the district's weather closure of schools procedures and announcements process.

The district aims to keep schools open on every regular instructional day, including those with snowfall. However, the final decision to send students to school resides with the parent or guardian since they are most familiar with the specific road and weather conditions around their home and community.

Weather Closure of Schools (Outside School Hours)

Any decision to close schools for the safety of children will be made by the Superintendent. Parents, students, and staff will be informed of the Superintendent's decision via: the school district website at www.westvancouverschools.ca and a School Messenger email

We endeavour to communicate this information to parents and staff by 6:00 a.m. on the day of closure.

Weather Closure of Schools (During School Hours)

If weather conditions create a concern for the safety of students returning home, the school principal can decide to dismiss school early after consulting with the Superintendent. The

decision will be communicated to parents and students using the school's normal communication systems.

Student safety is our first priority. Every effort will be made to keep schools open, but parents are encouraged to establish a plan for their children in the event of early dismissal or school closure.
