SUMMARY OF LEARNING (REPORTS)

If you have forgotten your password, simply use your login and click on “forgot password”, and you should receive another temporary one (check your spam/junk folder if you do not receive it).

All Learning Updates #1 and #2, the final Summary of Learning Report, ELL reports (AIPs) and IEP reports will be posted on the Family Portal for the 2024/25 school year **until July 31, 2025**. **Paper copies will not be sent home**, so it is important that you print and/or download/save your child’s reports to your computer as a PDF for future reference. SIGN UP FOR BAND! GRADE 6 AND 7 BAND REGISTRATIONS IS OPEN FOR 2025-2026 (FOR CURRENT GR 5/6 STUDENTS)

Band registration for elementary concert band is now open for the 2025-2026 school year. Band is an optional program offered to Grade 6 and 7 students where they learn an instrument to play as a group. Ridgeview has had a strong tradition with music and for opportunities like choir and band. Band can be a place where students can make connections and to find a sense of belonging at school. Band players help the school with showcasing music for school events, assemblies and district events too – besides the pure joy of learning how to play an instrument and playing together! If you are extending the summer break and returning after we begin classes on Tuesday, September 2nd, please keep in mind AP 300 Student Registration and Enrolment states that the unconfirmed whereabouts of an absent registered student will be removed from the school register if the student has not returned by 3:00 pm on the Thursday after school opening (September 4th). We do not hold seats as finalizing school and district enrollment, operations and planning will take priority over travel plans. EARLY PICK UPS (Gr K-7)

To avoid disruptions during class time, we encourage families to schedule appointments outside of school hours, however, we understand it is occasionally unavoidable. Should you require to pick your child up early, it is always best to email their teacher (and copy the office) in advance so that they are aware. During the end of day routines, we will not be able to accommodate early pick ups from 2:30-2:40pm unless we have been given previous notice. Thank you for your cooperation.

REMEMBER TO PACK LUNCH UTENSILS FROM HOME (Gr K-7)

A reminder to please pack a reusable fork, spoon or chopsticks from home should your child require a utensil to eat what they have for their lunch. This includes if they are receiving hot lunch. **Utensils are not provided with hot lunch and we do not have utensils available in the office.**
