EARLY PICK UPS (GR K-7)

To avoid disruptions during class time, we encourage families to schedule appointments outside of school hours, however, we understand it is occasionally unavoidable. Should you require to pick your child up early on the odd occasion, please be sure to email their teacher (and copy the office) in advance so the teacher is aware to help minimize disruption. During the end of day routines, we will not be able to accommodate early pick ups from 2:30-2:40pm unless we have been given previous notice. Thank you for your cooperation.

PLEASE - NO GUM AT SCHOOL (GR K-7)

Parents – we need your help! Please do not send gum with your child to school. This is an expectation and has been communicated previously. It is highly distracting when we engage with students and we are finding gum attached to desks, water fountains and furniture as we have zero means to dispose of it. If we see a child chewing gum – we will ask them to put it in a paper towel and to bring home in their lunch, etc. (as we are pack lunch in/ pack lunch out). Thank you for your cooperation in advance with this small issue.

Dress for the Weather (Gr K-7)

As more typical Fall weather is upon us, please ensure your child is prepared to go outside in all weather conditions when they leave the house in the morning. We also strongly encourage every student to have a set of extra clothes (including socks/shoes) at school should they get wet and/or muddy during the day. Hoodies and/or down jackets are great on cooler days – but not effective in the rain. Please make sure your child can stay dry in the rain, from jackets to footwear. STUDENT ABSENCES / LATE ARRIVALS (GR K-7)

It is extremely important that student absences/late arrivals be reported to the school office prior to 8:40am by leaving a voice message on the 'Call Back' phone line at 604-981-1252 or by emailing Mrs. Lytle (slytle@wvschools.ca). Please call each day your child is absent or if you know your child will be away for an extended period of time (such as holidays), please email the office so that this information can be recorded on the Call Back 'long term' form.

REMEMBER TO PACK LUNCH UTENSILS FROM HOME (GR K-7)

A reminder to please pack a reusable fork, spoon or chopsticks from home should your child require a utensil to eat what they have for their lunch. This includes if they are receiving hot lunch. Utensils are not provided with hot lunch and we do not have utensils available in the office.
